



- 460. **Trio of Uniforms of an American Hammer Thrower in Munich, 1972.** Olympic Parade and Travel Uniforms, both with U.S. team patches and ties, and Competitor Uniform sizes L / XL, and Belts. All in good condition, belt worn, buckle good. Plus assorted items from Mexico 1975, AAU USA cap, 4 Russian souvenirs, and a travel bag. An interesting group from an American participant. (\$675)
- 461. 10<sup>th</sup> Olympic Congress in Varna, 1973. Guest of National Olympic Committee Badge. Silvered, 28x33mm, rings in color. With green ribbon and "INVITE" on green bar. EF. (\$100)
- 462. **Paavo Nurmi Memorial Medal, 1973.** Cast silver, 58mm, 256 grams (8-1/3 oz), by Sporrong. Bust l. in high relief of famous Olympic runner in the 1920's (1897 1973). Rev. "Antwerpen-Paris-Amsterdam" *Nurmi won 1500m in Paris 1924; 5000m in Paris 1924 and Amsterdam 1928; and 10000m in Antwerp 1920 and Amsterdam 1928.* Numbered, limited edition. EF. (\$175)
- 463. **50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the 1924 Chamonix Winter Olympic** Games Medal, 1974. Copper, 67mm, by L. Schaefer-Hardy. Highrelief Alpine mountains with Chamonix and Montblanc, Olympic legend below. Rev. Downhill ski run between fir trees. EF. (\$125)

- 464. **Official Torch.** Silver colored, 74.6cm (29.4"), designed by Vereinigte Metallwerke, Rantshofen. The torch design includes a ski jump. Less than 100 made. VF-EF. Rare torch. (\$5,000)
- 465. **Participation Medal.** Silvered AE, 50mm, by W. Pichl. Innsbruck Olympic emblem on ice crystals within German legend. Rev. Bergisel ski jump, panorama of Innsbruck and Austrian Alps in background. Toned EF, in original box. Very scarce in this condition. (\$450)
- 466. **Austrian Army Badge.** Silvered, 30x58mm. "Bundesheer" on redorange bar. Toned EF. (\$250)
- 467. **Official Badge.** Red and white enameled bronze, 42x68mm. Symbol above logo. 2 prongs on rev. EF. Rare. (\$150)
- c468. Austrian Team Pin. Goldplated, blue enamel, 29x25mm. EF. (\$65)

- 477. **Silver Second Place Winner's Medal Awarded in Volleyball.** Silver, 60mm, by Cassioli (obv.). Victory seated above stadium. Rev. Open laurel wreath, Montreal logo at top. Edge inscribed "Volleyball". EF, lt. rubbing, with chain. Housed in wooden case and black leather slipcover with silver logo. (\$5,750)
- 478. **Participation Medal.** Copper, 45mm, by G. Huel/P. Pelletier. Montreal Olympic stadium over French legend in two lines. Rev. Montreal Olympic emblem, a stylized "M" above Olympic rings. EF, mottled toning, in leather presentation case. (\$300)
- 479. **Participant's Badge.** Cupro-nickel, 28x56mm, red and green enamel. EF. (\$150)
- 480. **Soviet Team Medal.** Bronze, 60mm. Soviet emblem, flag enameled in red. Rev. Montreal logo. EF. (\$100)

- c494. **Bronze Third Place Winner's Medal Awarded in Luge.** Bronze, 80mm, made by Tiffany & Co. Hand holding torch between legend and rings, Adirondack mountains in background. Rev. Large conifer branch, logo at top, award legend in 3 lines at left (2 of the 3 award lines blended out on photo). One of 73 award medals. EF. Rare. (\$5,000)
- 495. Participation Medal. Nickel-silver, 76mm, by M. Jovine. Modern relief views of the nine winter sports. Rev. Lake Placid Olympic emblem surrounded by the words of the Olympic oath in four concentric circles. EF. (\$375)
- 496. **Large Red Austrian Team Pin.** Gilt, red enamel, 33x38mm. EF. (\$80)
- 497. Official Calendar 1980 Medal. Goldplated bronze, 76mm, made by Metallic Art. Official logo surrounded by 8 Olympic winter sports. Rev. Large monthly calendar between flaming torches, crossed hockey sticks and skis below. EF. (\$150)
- 498. **1980 Ski Dollar.** Eisenhower dollar with Lake Placid 1980 and skier counter stamp. Proof FDC, partial lt. toning, in plastic case. (\$100)
- c499. **Commemorative Skater Porcelain Decanter.** Multicolor bisque porcelain, 34cm (13.4") tall, by Cyrus Noble. Female skater before Olympic flame, base surrounded by Olympic events, legend behind torch. EF. (\$125)
- c500. U.S. Ski Team Slalom Porcelain Decanter. Multicolor, 13.6x11.6cm (4.9"x4.6"), made by Ski Country. Female slalom skier, U.S. ski team logo on side. *Sold to raise funds for the American ski team in Lake Placid 1980.* EF, boxed. (\$125)



501. **Commemorative Olympic Flame Porcelain Plate.** Blue and white, 19.1cm (7.5"), by Delano Studios, from an original design by Marie Lanza Wiese. Olympic fire over logo encircled by legend. EF. (\$100)

# MOSCOW, 22<sup>nd</sup> OLYMPIC GAMES, 1980

- 502. **Bronze Third Place Winner's Medal Awarded for Boxing.**Bronze, 59mm, by Ilya Postol. Female seated above stadium. Rev. Olympic flame in cauldron over stadium. Edge inscribed with event. With loop and ring. Mottled EF/VF-EF. (\$2,200)
- 503. **Official Torch.** Aluminum alloy, gray and gold. Moscow logo and legend in red, 56.1cm (22-1/2") tall, designed by Boris Tuchin. Runners carried the torch during the 30-day torch relay from Olympia, Greece through Bulgaria and Romania to Moscow, a distance of 4976 km. EF, lt. wear. (\$1,250)
- 504. Participation Medal. Tombac, 60mm, by A. Leonova. Moscow Olympic emblem over Olympic stadium. Rev. View of Red Square in Moscow. EF. In presentation box. (\$175)
- 505. United States Olympic Team Congressional Medal. Goldplated bronze, 75mm, by Tiffany & Co. Flaming torch between rings and "1980", United States Olympic Team" above. Rev. Five doves flying towards "Games of the XXII Olympiad". No ribbon. This medal, styled like a winner's medal, was presented to American 1980 Moscow team members at a ceremony by President Carter after the United States decided to boycott the Moscow Olympic Games in protest of the Soviet invasion of Afghanistan. EF, spots obv. (\$500)
- Radio Japan Pool Pin. Gilt, white and red enamel, 17x22mm.
  EF. Scarce. (\$100)
- 507. **Opening Ceremony Bugle.** Brass, 20.5x31.6cm (8.1"x12.4"). Moscow logo and "Moscow 80" in Cyrillic on side, makers mark and number. VF-EF. (\$750)

c508. **Tall Smiling Mascot Misha Bear.** Light brown plush, 47cm (18.5") tall. Smiling Misha with Olympic belt. EF. (\$200)

- 509. Commemorative Misha with Honey Pot Plaque. Embossed multicolor brass, 16.1x25cm (6.3"x9.8"). Misha holding honey pot standing on winner's podium, bees and flowers around him. FF (\$100)
- c510. **Commemorative Decorative Porcelain Samovar.** Handpainted in green, purple and pink, 21.5cm (8.5") tall. Spout, handle, top and bottom are goldplated. Handle on top is a little teapot with the Moscow Olympic logo. EF. Attractive. (\$175)
- 511. Large Commemorative Mascot Misha Clear Glass Plate. 26.3x25.8cm (10.4"x10.2"). Smiling Misha surrounded by 5-ringed flowers. EF. (\$125)
- 512. **Soccer Whistle.** Wood, 24cm (9.4"), with brass plate featuring Moscow logo. Soccer ball on top of whistle. EF. (\$125)
- 513. **Judge's Diploma.** Multicolor, 29.3x42.2cm (11.5"x16.6"). *Judge won medals in Rome 1960 and Tokyo 1964 (gold)*. Abt. EF, sm. crease, some white-out. (\$200)
- 514. Diploma for the Olympic Order in Gold Bestowed by the IOC (1980's). Stiff embossed paper, 28x37cm (11"x14.6"). Laurel wreath with gold embossed Olympic rings over award legend, signed in black by IOC President Samaranch. The Olympic Order is the highest decoration presented by the IOC. It replaced the Olympic Diploma (see lot 51) in 1975. EF. Rare. (\$1,250)
- 515. Pair of Official Olympic Village Brochures. Olympic Village Guide for the Athletes, in French. And Olympic Village Arts Programme, in English. 70pp. and 47pp., both illustrated in color, 10.5x19.2cm. EF. (2 pcs.) (\$150)
