


## BARCELONA, 25<sup>th</sup> OLYMPIC GAMES, 1992

- c569. Gold First Place Winner's Medal. Goldplated silver, 70mm, by X. Corbero. Victory seated above stadium. Rev. Barcelona logo of jumping athlete over Olympic rings. Although IOC rules call for inscription of event on winner's medals, the Barcelona medals were not inscribed. Abt. EF, with ribbon in Olympic colors. (\$5,000)
- 570. **Participation Medal.** Burnished copper, 70mm, by X. Corbero. Spanish legend in four lines over Barcelona Olympic emblem, a stylized jumping athlete. Rev. Spiral and elongated bolt of lightning. EF. In original pouch. (\$125)
- 571. Complete Set of 32 U.S. Team Pins for Barcelona 1992. Multicolor enamel. Cased, under glass. Each athlete and some officials received a set from the U.S.O.C. They were never available to the public. New. (\$350)
- c572. **Complete Set of 14 Barcelona '92 NBC Pins.** Gilt, multicolor enamel. On original red velvet with cords and tassels. EF. (\$175)
- 573. **Lladro Olympic Events Porcelain Ball, 1992.** Bisque porcelain, partially pink and blue, 8cm (3.2") diameter, 9cm (3.5") tall. Illustrations of running, weightlifting, pole vault, shot put and swimming, crossed torches and laurel branches above "1992" on top. EF. (\$150)

### LILLEHAMMER, 17<sup>th</sup> OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 1994

- 574. **Official Torch.** Birchwood handle, 153cm (60") long, designed by A. Marandon and P.J. Kahrs. The upper part is cast aluminum with 7 wicks for lighting the torch with paraffin. This torch was used in the torch relay the wicks are burned but otherwise the torch is in good condition. Very scarce torch. (\$8,000)
- 575. **Participation Medal.** Copper, 66x76mm, by M. Kleppan. Pictograms of sporting events, ice crystals and Lillehammer Olympic emblem over Olympic rings. Rev. Modernistic ice crystal design with sports pictograms. EF, toning, in original wooden case. (\$400)
- 576. Complete Set of 14 U.S. Team Pins for Lillehammer 1994. In wooden case, under glass. Each athlete and some officials received a set from the U.S.O.C. They were never available to the public. New. (\$350)
- 577. **Olympic Skater Sculpture.** Iron, 32.2cm (12.7") tall. Pictogram figure skater. EF, lt. rust. In original wooden crate with numbered certificate. (\$200)
- 578. **Olympic Skier Sculpture.** Iron, 33x20cm (13"x7.9"). Pictogram figure of skier. EF, lt. rust. In original wooden crate with numbered certificate. (**\$200**)



c579. Complete Set of 16 Different Badges for the 104<sup>th</sup> IOC Session in Budapest, 1995. Gold plated, partially enameled, 35x65mm. All badges with different ribbons, and cords. EF. Plus "Welcome Guide" brochure, 40pp., 10.5x21cm (4.1"x8.3"), in French and English. Includes list of all badges issued. At this session, Salt Lake City was awarded the Winter Olympic Games 2002. Rare as a complete set. (\$2,500)

### ATLANTA, 26<sup>th</sup> OLYMPIC GAMES, 1996

- c580. Silver Second Place Winner's Medal Awarded in Swimming, Men's 4x200 Meters Freestyle Relay. Silver, 69mm, by Malcolm Grier Designers. Victory seated above stadium. Rev. Atlanta logo over laurel branches and pictogram. Edge engraved with name of event. With green and gold bordered ribbon with Atlanta logo. Housed in wooden presentation box with Atlanta logo. (\$5,000)
- 581. **Official Torch.** Aluminum and Georgia pecan wood, 80cm (31.5") length, designed by Peter Mastrogiannis. 22 reeds represent the cities where Olympic games were held since 1896. Gathered by 2 goldplated brass bands, the top band displays the Atlanta torch logo and the quilt of leaves design, the bottom band lists all Olympic cities since 1896. The wooden pecan handle represents the connection of the flame between heaven and earth. *The flame was lit in Olympia. It reached Los Angeles on April 27 and ended 84 days later in Atlanta, carried by 10,000 relay runners, horses, bicycles, trains, ships, and hydroplanes.* EF. (\$1,750)
- 582. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm. Official torch logo. Rev. Quilt of leaves. Unc, cased. (\$125)















- 584. The Coca-Cola Olympic Pin of the Night Atlanta 1996 Set. 17 pins, goldplated, black and white enamel. Mounted on board, in gold frame, under glass, 42.3x29.6cm (16.7"x11.6"). EF. (\$125)
- c585. Atlanta 1996 Commemorative Framed Train Pin Set. 102.2x18.5cm (40.2"x7.3")., by Imprinted. Izzy drives the train "All Aboard to Atlanta!" Ten cars are pins from 1000 Days, Oct. 23, 1993 to 100 Days, April 10, 1996. Matted and framed for wall display. EF. (\$125)
- 586. Waterford Crystal Atlanta 1996 Olympic Torch. 10.2x20cm (4"x2.9"), 3.1cm (1.2") thick. Cauldron with "100 Atlanta 1996" and Olympic rings, flame logo above. EF, in original case with silver Atlanta logo. (\$175)
- 587. **Trio of Commemorative Bells and a Thimble.** Bells chrome-plated, 10cm (3.9") tall. Thimble, pewter, 4.8cm (1.9") tall. All with logo. EF. (3 pcs.) (\$90)
- 588. **Large Athens '96 Bid Banner.** Cream colored linen with green design, 352x238cm (138.6"x93.7"). Olympic rings over "Athens '96", olive branch at left. EF. (\$175)
- 589. **The Atlanta 1996 Dream Tour Banner.** White plastic with color design, 298.8x85.6cm (117.6"x33.7"). The Dream Tour was organized by Chevrolet, and publicized the Atlanta Olympic Games with athletic event tryouts, Memorabilia exhibits, etc. Logo in center, Olympic pictograms on either side. EF. (\$175)
- c590. Starting Number. Multicolor, 23x20.5cm (9.1"x8.1"). EF. (\$75)

# NAGANO, 18<sup>th</sup> OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 1998

- c591. **Official Torch.** Aluminum, partially gilt, 55cm (21.7") tall, weight 1.5kg (3.3 pounds). Designed after ancient Japanese torches called Taimatsu. It shows the Nagano emblem and sports pictograms. A brightly colored cord wrapped around the lower part forms the grip. Fueled with clean burning propane, it burnt for about 20 minutes. The torch relay in Japan took place from January 6 until February 7, when the Olympic fire was lit during the opening ceremony. EF. Rare and beautiful torch. (\$5.500)
- 592. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm. Nagano logo over legend. Rev. Wooded mountainside. EF, in box with gilt logo. (\$375)
- c593. Youth Volunteer Kimono for the Nagano 1998 Bid. Blue, white and black linen, size 5. Large Nagano 1998 bid logo in Olympic colors on back over rows of snowflakes. Abt. EF. (\$100)
- c594. Olympic Figure Skating Medalist Tara Lipinsky Musical Snow Globe. 16.5cm (6.5") tall, Tara, gold medalist at Nagano 1998 Olympic winter games, swirls around in snow. EF, boxed. (\$75)
- 595. Group of 27 Different Daily Programs Including the Opening Ceremony Program. Daily Programs are 21x29.6cm (8.3"x11.7"), 4pp., in color. Highlights include Men's Single Luge Final (Hacker, USA, gold), Women's Hockey Gold Medal Game, Women's Figure Skating Free Program (Lipinski gold), all sessions of Freestyle Skating, etc. All EF. (27 pcs.) (\$325)
- 596. **Inauguration Medal of the New Greek Olympic Committee Headquarters, 1999.** Bronze, 60mm, by Th. Theoharis. Open book with busts of IOC Presidents Vikelas, Coubertin and Samaranch. Rev. View of headquarters. EF, with brochure, cased. (\$100)

# SYDNEY, 27<sup>th</sup> OLYMPIC GAMES, 2000

- c597. **Official Torch.** Three layers consisting of polished stainless steel, anodized aluminum and coated aluminum, 77cm (30.5"), designed by Blue Sky Design, Sydney, manufactured by G.A. & L. Harrington. The three layers represent earth, fire and water. EF. (\$2.250)
- 598. **Participation Medal.** Silvered AE, 50mm. Sydney Olympic logo. Rev. 3-line legend over Olympic rings. EF, cased. (\$175)
- 599. **Greek Torchbearer Pin for Sydney 2000.** Multicolor enamel, 19x28mm. EF. (\$75)



- c600. The 2000 Olympic Torch Relay Album with 16 Pins. Multicolor cardboard album, 28.5x27cm (11.2"x10.6"). Opens up to reveal map of Australia with 15 multicolor pins and goldplated 2000 Olympic Torch Relay State Pin of NSW, text on left side. Complete set. EF. (\$175)
- c601. **Commemorative Wedgwood Winner's Medal.** Blue and white jasper, 74mm, (2.9"), made by Wedgwood. Female seated above stadium, "Games of the XXVII Olympiad" in 4 lines at right. Rev. Sydney logo and Wedgwood markings in gold. EF, boxed. (\$175)
- c602. **Opening Ceremony Suitcase.** Yellow, 35x25cm (13.8"x9.8"), 12cm (4.7") deep. Complete with opening ceremony program, pin, CD, flash light, lighting armband, socks. *Sought-after souvenir*. (\$150)
- 603. **Trio of Small Plush Mascots Syd, Olly and Millie.** 12 to 14cm (4.7 to 5.5") tall. With key chains and original tags. EF. (3 pcs.) (\$100)
- 604. **Mascot Olly Dressed as Volleyball Player.** Multicolor plush, 26cm (10.2") tall. EF. (\$75)

- c606. Sydney 2000 Bid Poster for Sydney 2000 Sunday Race. Meeting at Royal Randwick Horse Race Course, 1993. Multicolor, 43.8x59.8cm (17.2"x23.5"). One of 100 posters. Lt. marginal creases o.w. EF. (\$200)
- 607. (Poster) Pair of "7 Network Australia" Posters 1998 for Sydney 2000. Multicolor, 41.8x59.1cm (`6.5"x23.3"). Nagano program and Nagano venues, with Sydney 2000 logo and Australian NOC emblem. Less than 100 each were made and distributed to various media/advertising outlets in Nagano 1998. EF. (2 pcs.) (\$400)
- c608. (Autographed Poster) Sydney A Sense of Place. Stiff paper, multicolor 51.2x42.8cm (20.5"x16.9"), designed by Judith Wise, issued by Sydney Olympic Coordination Authority before the Sydney logo was revealed. The only poster for the Sydney Olympic Games which depicts all venue sites. With signature in pencil and descriptive flyer by Judith Wise. EF. (\$150)
- 609. **Journey Book with Numbered Sydney Logo Lithograph. Released at the Sydney Logo Unveiling, September 1997.** Journey Book 22pp., illus. in color, 25x25cm (9.8"x9.8"). Plus blindstamped logo, 25x25cm, numbered 175/500. Boxed. Presented to dignitaries who attended the logo unveiling. EF. (\$275)

- c610. **Image Guidelines.** Multicolor, 31x30cm (12.2"x11.8"). 12 topics and 2 CD's in blue plastic ring binder with slipcover in blue padding with Sydney logo plaque. Numbered. EF. Scarce. (\$400)
- c611. Official Sports Programs Prestige Collector's Set of 29 Multicolor Programs. 21x27.5cm (8.3"x10.8"), 51 to 83pp. illus. each. Housed in clear acrylic case with "Sydney 2000" and rings in silver. Limited edition. (\$750)

- 614. **Official Torch.** Silver colored metal and glass, 83.8cm (33") tall. Shaped like a fiery icicle in motion, the polished silver colored bottom bears the motto "Light the fire within"; center metal and glass top section in "frozen flame" texture with logo on metal part. EF. (\$1,800)
- 615. **Participation Medal.** Bronze plaque, 49x89mm, by O.T. Tanner. "Light the Fire Within" motto and Salt Lake City 2002 logo on Utah's famous arch, mountain view in back. Rev. Three athletes dashing out of mountain between legend and Olympic rings. EF, cased, in linen bag with circular leather logo. (\$400)
- c616. **114<sup>th</sup> IOC Session in Mexico, 2002. Press Badge.** Chrome plated, blue and red enamel, 29x49mm. Victory over Olympic rings between legend. With yellow ribbon. EF. Scarce. (\$250)
- c617. **Mongolian Team Opening Ceremony Fox Fur Hat.** Hat with 3 fox tails in back and on sides. EF. (\$150)
- 618. Complete Set of 29 Olympic Village Newspapers "Olympic Record", January 29 to February 26, 2002. Each issue 8pp., illustrated in color, 29x43cm (11.4x16.9"). A wealth of information. EF. Scarce set (29 pcs.). (\$225)

# ATHENS, 28<sup>th</sup> OLYMPIC GAMES, 2004

- c619. **Official Torch.** Silver colored metal and olive wood, 68cm (26.8") tall. The torch resembles an olive leaf, and the design wants to express "Pan Metron Ariston" (all things in moderation, translated from Greek). A simple and beautiful design. EF. (\$2,000)
- c620. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 50mm. Athens 2004 logo. Rev. Games legend. Greek text and wavy decoration on both sides. Mounted inside cardboard, between color covers. Space for participation diploma inside back cover. EF. (\$275)
- c621. Athens 2004 Russian Gold Medal Winner Award Plaque. Goldplated, multicolor, mounted on wooden plaque, 23x30.6cm (9.1"x12"). With 3 affixed medals, 2 showing Greece and Russia. In red velvet case. EF. (\$750)
- c622. Complete Czech Team Pin Set. 6 multicolor pins and badges, housed in blue case with black velvet lining. EF. (\$325)
- 623. 116<sup>th</sup> IOC Session in Athens 2004. Session Organising Committee Service Badge. Gilt, 32x50mm. With purple-black-purple ribbon. EF. (\$200)
- 624. Official 1896 Silver Winner's Medal Replica made in 2004 by the Historical and Ethnological Society of Greece. Silver plated, 50mm, after Chaplain. Bust of Zeus facing, holding statue of Victory. Rev. View of Acropolis. P-l Unc., in blue velvet case. (\$150)
- c625. **Beautiful Opening Ceremony Robe and Hat Worn by the Uzbek Flag Bearer.** Dark blue velvet robe, 138cm (54.3") long, richly embroidered with gold thread and sequins on front, back and sleeves. With silky white and gold hat, decorated with beads. *The flag bearer led the Uzbek team in the opening ceremony.* EF. (2 pcs.) (\$950)
- c626. Large Commemorative Copper Winner's Olive Wreath. 29cm (11.4") wide, mounted on black marble base, 28.4cm (11.2") tall with "Athens Olympic Games 2004" gold-colored plaque. Real olive plant coated with green patinated copper. *All winners in Athens 2004 received an olive wreath in addition to their medals.* EF. (\$350)
- c627. Large Commemorative Goldplated Winner's Olive Wreath. Wreath 25cm (9.8") wide, mounted on clear acrylic base, 27cm (10.8") tall. Real olive plant coated with 24 Karat gold, made by SM Art. All winners in Athens 2004 received an olive wreath in addition to their medals. EF. (\$350)
- 628. Commemorative Olympic Games in Athens 1896-2004 Embossed Silver Wall Plaque. 950 hallmarked silver, 13x10cm, on wooden plaque, 18.8x16cm (7.4"x6.3"). Two ancient Greek wrestlers surrounded by olive branches and "Athens 1896-2004" legend. EF, boxed. (\$150)

- 629. Commemorative Address Book with Silver Plaque and Dust from Ancient Olympia. Address book with leather covers, 15x21.3cm (5.9"x8.4").
