c1. Athens 1896. Gold Participation Medal. Goldplated bronze, 50 mm , by N. Lytras. Seated Nike holding laurel wreath over phoenix rising out of flames, Acropolis in background. Rev. 5-line Greek legend. Presented to very high officials. Abt. EF/EF. (\$1,750)
2. Athens 1896. Participation Medal. Bronze, 50 mm , by N. Lytras. Seated Nike holding laurel wreath, phoenix rising out of flames, Acropolis in background. Rev. 5-line Green legend in laurel wreath. EF, sm. nick obv., sm. rb. (\$1,250)
3. Athens 1896. Participation Medal. As preceding medal but VF+, rbs. (\$900)
c4. Athens 1906. Gold Participation Medal. Goldplated bronze, 50 mm , by N. Lytras. Seated Nike holding laurel wreath over phoenix emerging from flames, Acropolis in background. Rev. Greek legend in wreath. VF-EF, tiny rb. (\$975)
5. Athens 1906. Silver Participation Medal. Silvered bronze, 50 mm , by N. Lytras. Seated Nike holding laurel wreath over phoenix emerging from flames, Acropolis in background. Rev. Greek legend in wreath. EF. $\mathbf{( \$ 1 , 5 0 0 )}$
6. Athens 1906. Cased Bronze Participation Medal. As preceding medal, but bronze. Fine-VF/VF, in red round case. (\$700)
7. London 1908. Cased Steward's Presentation Participation Medal. Silvered, 50 mm , by B. MacKennal. Fame on globe. Rev. Winner in quadriga. EF , sm. spots on rev. In blue box with gold inscription on top, box stained on back. $(\mathbf{\$ 1 , 7 5 0})$
8. London 1908. Silver Participation Medal. As preceding medal, EF, no box. $(\$ 1,250)$
9. London 1908. Bronze Participation Medal. As preceding medal, but bronze. EF, sm. spots, no box. (\$800)

c10. Stockholm 1912. Bronze Participation Medal. Bronze, 51mm, by MacKennal/Lindberg. Zeus seated on Ionian column holding figure of Victory, Stockholm in back. Rev. Quadriga with triumphant winner dashing 1. Only 100 medals were struck in bronze for presentation to high dignitaries. EF, rns. Rare. $\mathbf{( \$ 2 , 5 0 0 )}$
11. Stockholm 1912. Participation Medal. Pewter, 51 mm , by Lindberg/MacKennal. Zeus seated on Ionian column holding figure of Nike, Stockholm in back. Rev. Quadriga with triumphant winner dashing 1. EF. (\$400)
12. Stockholm 1912. Participation Medal. As preceding medal, abt. EF. (\$350)
13. Antwerp 1920. Participation Medal. Bronze, 60 mm , by P. Theunis. Nike standing before tripod crowning victorious athletes. Rev. Flying Victory crowning charioteer in biga. Toned EF/abt. EF, minor rb. on rev., sm. spots. Very scarce. (\$650)
14. Paris 1924. Boxed Participation Medal. Bronze, 55 mm , by R. Bénard. City view of Paris over French legend in three lines. Rev. Victory with laurel wreaths crowning victorious athletes. EF, spots, in presentation box (VF). (\$700)

15. Paris 1924. Participation Medal. Bronze, 55 mm , by R. Bénard. City view of Paris over French legend in three lines. Rev. Victory with laurel wreaths crowning victorious athletes. EF. (\$400)
16. Amsterdam 1928. Boxed Participation Medal. Bronze, 55 mm , by J.C. Wienecke. Nude male and female athlete on podium holding torch over Olympic flame. Rev. Nike over Marathon Tower, shield of Amsterdam between two hemispheres. EF. In original box (rare). (\$950)
17. Amsterdam 1928. Participation Medal. As preceding medal, EF, no box. (\$400)
18. Los Angeles 1932. Cased Participation Medal. Bronze, 60 mm , by J. Kilenyi. Standing athlete carrying unfurled banner of the $X^{\text {th }}$ Olympiad. Rev. Two seated female figures supporting shield of the United States. EF, in brown cardboard box, lined in velvet, scuffed. (\$1,275)
19. Los Angeles 1932. Participation Medal. As preceding medal, EF. No box. (\$1,100)
c20. Berlin 1936. Boxed Participation Medal. Cast bronze, 70 mm , by O. Placzek. Five athletes representing the five continents, pulling the ropes of the Olympic Bell. Rev. Olympic Bell embossed with German Eagle holding Olympic rings, within five concentric circles. EF, spot, red-brown patina, in presentation box (stained on top). (\$375)
21. Berlin 1936. Participation Medal. As preceding medal but browngreen patina. No box. EF. (\$325)
22. Berlin 1936. Participation Medal. As preceding medal but brown patina, VF-EF, spots on rev. (\$250)
23. London 1948. Participation Medal. Bronze, 51 mm , by B. MacKennal/ J. Pinches. City view of London over legend in three lines, Olympic rings below. Rev. Quadriga with triumphant winner dashing 1. VF-EF. (\$300)
24. Helsinki 1952. Boxed Participation Medal. Bronze, 54 mm , by K. Räsänen. Stylized athletes' heads superimposed over the Olympic Stadium. Rev. Male and female athletes to left holding torches over Olympic rings. EF, in box (faded on top). (\$275)
25. Helsinki 1952. Participation Medal. As preceding medal, no box, EF. (\$250)
c26. Stockholm 1956. Participation Medal. Bronze, uniface, 42x50mm, by J. Sjösvärd. Ancient Greek horseman 1. over Olympic rings, the official emblem of the equestrian Olympic Games. Name erased on back. EF, sm. spot obv. $(\mathbf{\$ 4 , 2 5 0})$
27. Melbourne 1956. Cased Participation Medal. Bronze, 63 mm , by A. Meszaros. Olympic rings over Melbourne coat of arms within legend. Rev. Olympic motto within circle of athletes marching in pairs. EF, in clear acrylic round box, lt. wear. (\$350)

34. Moscow 1980. Cased Participation Medal. Tombac, 60 mm , by A. Leonova. Moscow Olympic emblem over Olympic stadium. Rev. View of Red Square in Moscow. EF, in presentation box. (\$200)
35. Los Angeles 1984. Cased Participation Medal. Bronze, 60 mm , by D. Sterner. Olympic torch head within legend. Rev. Los Angeles Olympic emblem over Olympic rings and laurel branches. EF, in original box. (\$325)
36. Seoul 1988. Cased Participation Medal. Bronze, 60 mm , by K. Kwanghyun. South Gate below mountain, cloud, crane, and sun. Rev. Seoul Olympic emblem over English legend in two lines. EF, in presentation case. (\$350)
37. Barcelona 1992. Participation Medal in Pouch. Burnished copper, 70 mm , by X. Corbero. Spanish legend in four lines over Barcelona Olympic emblem, a stylized jumping athlete. Rev. Spiral and elongated bolt of lightning. EF, in original pouch. (\$175)
38. Atlanta 1996. Boxed Participation Medal. Bronze, 60 mm . Official torch logo. Rev. Quilt of leaves. Unc, boxed. (\$150)
39. Sydney 2000. Cased Participation Medal. Silvered AE, 50 mm . Sydney Olympic logo. Rev. 3-line legend over Olympic rings. EF, in plastic case. (\$200)
40. Athens 2004. Participation Medal. Bronze, 50mm. Athens 2004 logo. Rev. Games legend. Greek text and wavy decoration on both sides. Mounted inside cardboard, between color covers. Space for participation diploma inside back cover. EF. (\$275)

c46. Cortina d’Ampezzo 1956 Winter. Cased Gold Participation Medal. Goldplated silver, 45 mm , by C. Affer. Female head facing, crowned by Olympic rings, flame in lower r. Rev. Snowflake superimposed on Mount Pomagagnon. EF, lt. wear on obv. high point. In blue leather case with affixed color Olympic rings. Minimum Bid $(\mathbf{\$ 3 , 5 0 0})$
47. Cortina d'Ampezzo 1956 Winter. Silver Participation Medal. As preceding medal but silver, 45 mm . EF, in blue leather case (scuffed) with affixed Olympic Rings in color. Minimum Bid $\mathbf{( \$ 2 , 5 0 0 )}$
48. Cortina d'Ampezzo $\mathbf{1 9 5 6}$ Winter. Participation Medal. Bronze, 45 mm , by C. Affer. Female head facing, crowned by Olympic rings, flame in lower r. Rev. Snowflake superimposed on Mount Pomagagnon. Toned EF. (\$875)
c49. Cortina d'Ampezzo 1956 Winter. Small-Size Gold Participation Medal. As preceding medal, goldplated silver, but 40 mm . EF. Very rare. Minimum Bid $\mathbf{( \$ 4 , 0 0 0 )}$
c50. Cortina d'Ampezzo 1956 Winter. Small-Size Silver Participation Medal. As preceding medal, but silver, 40 mm . EF, in original paper wrapper. Very rare. Minimum Bid. $(\mathbf{3 , 0 0 0})$
44. St. Moritz 1948 Winter. Cased Participation Medal. Bronze, 40 mm , by Wiederkehr. Olympic rings over French legend in five lines. Rev. Symbolic figure of Victory, mountain range in back. Toned EF, in red case with gold Olympic rings on top, very ltly. scuffed. (\$1,500)
45. Oslo 1952 Winter. Cased Participation Medal. Copper, 56 mm , by V. Falireus. Oslo Olympic emblem, a silhouette of the Oslo City Hall with superimposed Olympic rings. Rev. Olympic motto surrounding large snowflake. EF, in presentation box (scuffed, VF). $(\$ 1,750)$
