



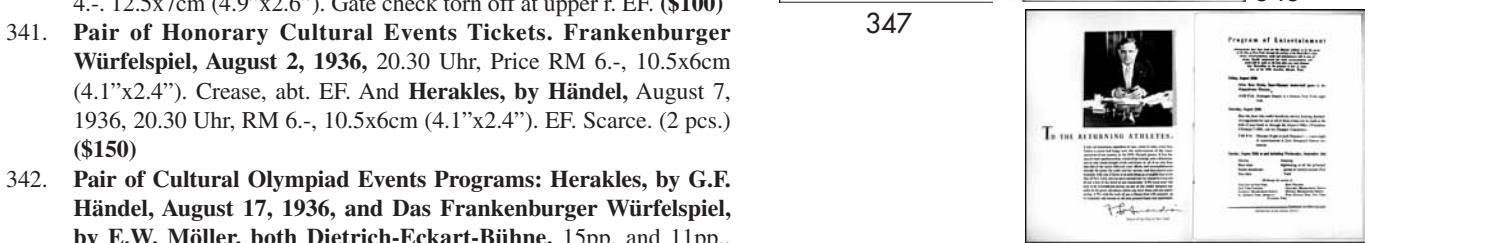
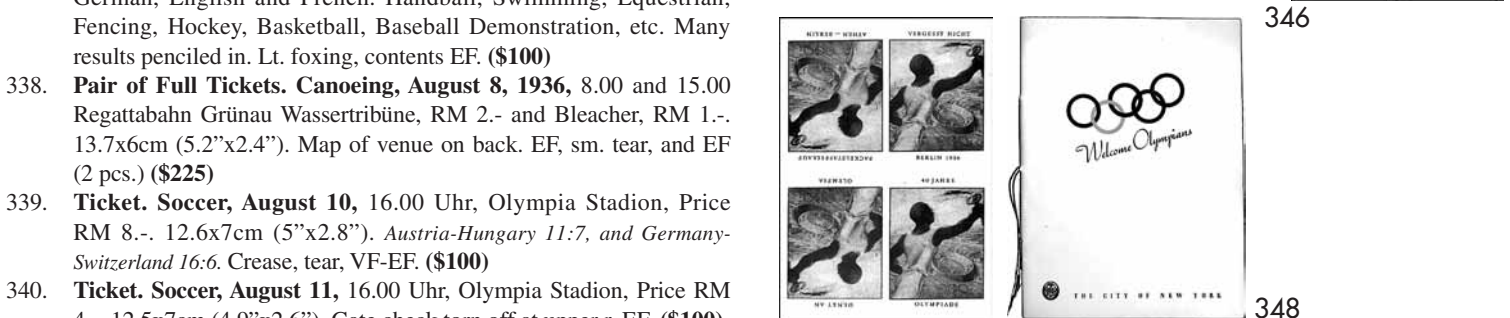
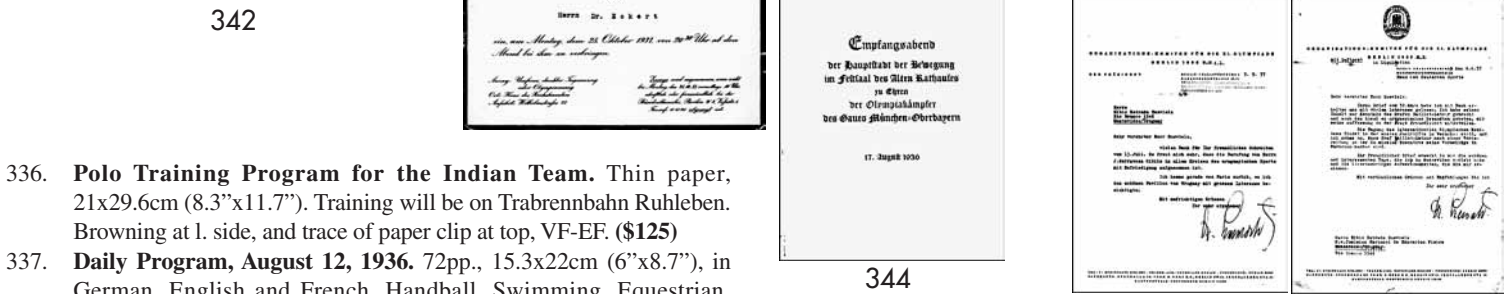

305. **Japanese Team Medal.** Silver, 36mm. Athlete standing on globe holding flag, large Olympic rings in back. Rev. Berlin Olympic bell encircled by Japanese legend. With loop. Toned EF. Very rare. (\$750)
306. **City of Berlin Presentation Medal on the Occasion of the 1936 Olympic Games.** Cast bronze, 9.3cm (3.7"). High relief mural crowned city shield surrounded by German legend. "The Reich Capital Berlin for the Olympic Games 1936" (transl.). Rev. Swastika above Olympic rings and Brandenburg Gate, 8-line German legend. EF, cased. (\$400)

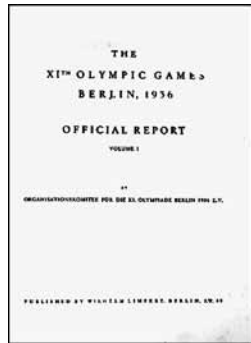

Group of four items includes Invitation by Propaganda Minister Goebbels, program of the Premiere, a ticket and a note of date change. Crease on two, o.w. EF. (4 pcs.) (\$300)
350. **(Guide) Saalbach, Hans. Dorf des Friedens.** Olympic Village of Peace, in German. Leipzig, 1936. 64pp. illus., 2-page foldout color map of the village in back, 15x21cm (5.9"x8.3"). - c362. **Commemorative Light Green Glass Bowl.** 15x11.5cm (5.9"x4.5"), 11.5cm (4.5") tall. Javelin thrower, 3 runners, wrestlers, and Olympic rings above "Helsinki 1940" on sides. EF. Rare. (\$975)
