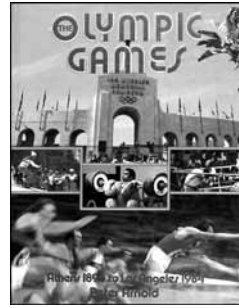

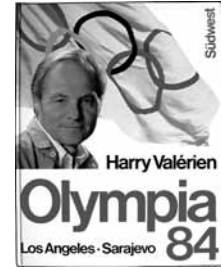

- 684. **Smiling Porcelain Misha.** Brown, 22cm (8.7") high, maker on bottom. Standing smiling Misha, Olympic rings on belt. EF. **(\$125)**
- 685. **Large Mascot Misha Plaque.** Bronze, 10.2cm (4"). Smiling Misha. Hanger on back. EF, sm. spots. **(\$75)**

SARAJEVO, 14th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 1984

- 687. **Official Torch.** Carried in the official torch run from Olympia, Greece to Sarajevo. Stainless steel cylinder in silver-colored aluminum alloy, bowl gold colored with "Sarajevo 84" legend. Length 57.5cm, weight 680 grams, manufactured by Nippon K. under the supervision of Mizuno Corp. Cylinder darkened from flame, a few bumps, VF+. Rare torch. **(\$6,500)**
- 688. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60x66mm uniface, by N. Mitric. Stylized "Sarajevo 84", within circle, above Sarajevo Olympic emblem. EF, in presentation box. **(\$550)**
- c689. **Light Brown Plush Mascot Voochko the Wolf.** 27cm (10.6"), by Tik-Tik, Yugoslavia. Light brown plush with dark brown nose, ears and paws. EF. **(\$225)**
- c690. **Dark Brown Plush Mascot Voochko the Wolf.** 27cm (10.6"), by Tik-Tik, Yugoslavia. Dark brown plush with lighter brown nose, ears, and paws. EF. **(\$225)**

- c691. **Mascot Voochko.** Black plush and stiff plastic, 25cm (9.8"). Voochko standing showing "V" sign, with "Sarajevo '84" and logo scarf, white tail. EF. Scarce. **(\$150)**

LOS ANGELES, 23rd OLYMPIC GAMES, 1984

- 692. **Official Torch.** Brass-finished aluminum with tan leather handle, length 56.5cm (22.4"). Bowl portrays Olympic rings, motto and L.A. Memorial Coliseum Stadium. Flame lit in Olympia, Greece on May 7, 1984, and it arrived in New York the following day. It took 82 days to carry the flame through 33 states, 9,375 miles, to Los Angeles. EF, in original black leather pouch. **(\$3,250)**
- c693. **Gold Sample Winner's Medal.** Goldplated, 60mm, by Jostens. Victory seated above stadium. Rev. Winner carried by jubilant athletes. With ribbon. EF. In Josten's wooden display case with glass sides, inscribed bronze plaque on top. **(\$2,500)**
- 694. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm, by D. Sterner. Olympic torch head within legend. Rev. Los Angeles Olympic emblem over Olympic rings and laurel branches. EF, in original box. **(\$375)**
- 695. **Silver Proof 1971-S Eisenhower Dollar.** Counterstamped on reverse center with 1984 Los Angeles Olympic Greek runners. One of 2,000, with insert, in plastic box. Unc., starting to tone. **(\$100)**
- 696. **1984 Sarajevo - Los Angeles Friendship Medal.** Bronze, 64mm. Dove of Peace over flaming Los Angeles torch and rings. Rev. Los Angeles and Sarajevo logos. EF, cased. **(\$100)**
- c697. **Commemorative Torch Relay Porcelain Plate.** Multicolor, 22cm (8.7"), by Escalera Production Art. Female torch runner with flaming torch, ten sports, Los Angeles City Hall and Olympic stadium in background. EF, with certificate and original box. **(\$150)**

- 712. **Participation Medal.** Burnished copper, 70mm, by X. Corbero. Spanish legend in four lines over Barcelona Olympic emblem, a stylized jumping athlete. Rev. Spiral and elongated bolt of lightning. EF, in original pouch. (\$175)

- LILLEHAMMER, 17th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 1994**
719. **Participation Medal.** Copper, 66x76mm, by M. Kleppan. Pictograms of sporting events, ice crystals and Lillehammer Olympic emblem over Olympic rings. Rev. Modernistic ice crystal design with sports pictograms. EF, toning, in original wooden case. (\$400)
720. **Official Souvenir Torch.** 60cm (23.8"), wood and metal engraved with 6 winter events. Accompanied by wooden display stand, 31cm (12.2") tall featuring Lillehammer logo and torch runner. EF. In original pictorial box. (\$300)
721. **Complete Set of 14 U.S. Team Pins for Lillehammer 1994.** In wooden case, under glass. Each athlete and some officials received a set from the U.S.O.C. They were never available to the public. New. (\$400)

ATLANTA, 26th OLYMPIC GAMES, 1996

723. **Official Centennial Torch.** Silvered aluminum and wood, 55cm (21.65"). Names of all 23 Olympic cities from 1896 to 1996 inscribed on torch. *The Hellenic Olympic Committee celebrated the 100th Anniversary of the 1896 Olympic Games in the Panathenean Stadium in Athens on April 6, 1996. Part of this celebration was the re-enactment of the 1896 Games. Olympic medalists and representatives of all cities who had hosted the Olympic Games since 1896 took part in the torch run within the stadium. Afterwards, they took the torches back to their Olympic cities for a ceremony.* Unused. EF. (\$2,750)

724. **Official Torch.** Aluminum and Georgia pecan wood, 80cm (31.5") length, designed by Peter Mastrogiannis. 22 reeds represent the cities where Olympic Games were held since 1896. Gathered by 2 goldplated brass bands, the top band displays the Atlanta torch logo and the quilt of leaves design, the bottom band lists all Olympic cities since 1896. The wooden pecan handle represents the connection of the flame between heaven and earth. *The flame was lit in Olympia. It reached Los Angeles on April 27 and ended 84 days later in Atlanta, carried by 10,000 relay runners, horses, bicycles, trains, ships, and hydroplanes.* EF. (\$2,500)
725. **Official Torch with Light.** As preceding torch but a light bulb fixture was added at the top; this required the removal of the tip of a reed. EF. (\$1,500)
726. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm. Official torch logo. Rev. Quilt of leaves. Unc, boxed. (\$175)
727. **Paralympic Participation Medal.** Copper, 63mm. Paralympic logo. Rev. Braille legend. EF, uneven toning on rev. (\$250)
- c728. **Cased Kuwait National Olympic Committee Medal.** Goldplated, multicolor enamel, 75mm. Logo surrounded by Arab and English legend. Rev. Radio/TV towers. EF, in blue case with gold logo. (\$150)
729. **Wooden Box for Atlanta 1996 Winner's Medal.** 13.3x17.8cm (5.2"x7"). Logo on top, inside lined with black velvet and gold logo. EF. (\$750)
730. **Official Atlanta 1996 Games Stein with Pewter Top.** Multicolor ceramic, 20.5cm (8.1") tall, by Ceramarte for Anheuser-Busch. Color logo between Melbourne 1956, Los Angeles 1932, London 1948, and Stockholm 1956 logos. EF, boxed. (\$100)
731. **Diploma. Women's Water Polo Team Physician.** Green, 21.6x27.9cm (8.5"x11"). EF. (\$200)
732. **Group of Four Olympic Stadium Athletics Tickets.** Yellow with multicolor quilt design, 19x6.2cm (7.5"x2.4"). July 26, 8 AM; July 27, 5:30 PM; July 29, 6 PM; and August 3, 6:30 PM. All but August 3 ticket unused. EF. (4 pcs.) (\$75)

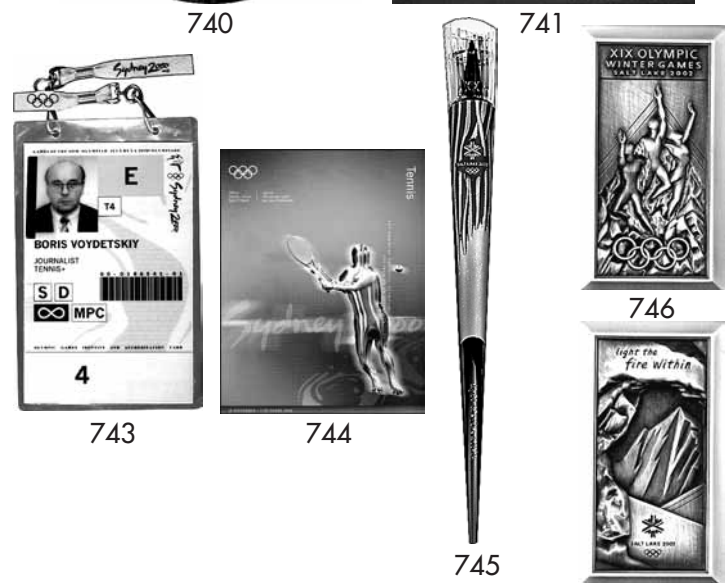

733. **Official Torch.** Aluminum, partially gilt, 55cm (21.7") long, weight 1.5kg (3.3 pounds). Designed after ancient Japanese torches called Taimatsu. It shows the Nagano emblem and sports pictograms, and a brightly colored orange cord wrapped around the lower part forms the grip. Fueled with clean burning propane, it burnt for about 20 minutes. *The torch relay in Japan took place from January 6 until February 7, when the Olympic fire was lit during the opening ceremony.* Choice EF, in original cardboard box. **(\$5,500)**
734. **Rare Official Presentation Torch.** As preceding torch but 27.7cm (10.9"). Only a very small number of these torches was made for presentation to high dignitaries. *Torch is housed in a wooden case, lined with green velvet. Brass plate commemorating the torch run Jan. 6 – Feb. 6, 1998.* EF. **(\$2,750)**
735. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm. Nagano logo over legend. Rev. Wooded mountainside. EF, in box with gilt logo. **(\$375)**
736. **Paralympic Games Participation Medal.** Bronze, 55mm. Paralympic Games legend. Rev. Braille legend. Unc., boxed. **(\$375)**

SYDNEY, 27th OLYMPIC GAMES, 2000

737. **Official Torch.** Three layers consisting of polished stainless steel, anodized aluminum and coated aluminum, 77cm (30.5"), designed by Blue Sky Design, Sydney, manufactured by G.A. & L. Harrington. The three layers represent earth, fire and water. EF. **(\$3,250)**
738. **Participation Medal.** Silvered, 50mm. Sydney Olympic logo. Rev. 3-line legend over Olympic rings. EF, in original box. **(\$250)**
739. **Polish Commemorative Torch Relay in Australia Medal.** Silvered bronze, 70mm. Torch runner over Australian continent running towards Sydney. Rev. Polish Olympic winner postal stamp, by Philatelic Society in Danzig. Unc., cased. **(\$175)**
740. **Azerbaijan Olympic Team Medal.** Goldplated, flag enameled in color, 60mm. Logo over flag. Rev. "With Compliments/NOC/of Azerbaijan". EF, cased. **(\$150)**
741. **Sydney 2000. Set of 23 Ukrainean Team Pins.** Goldplated, color enameled, 11x29mm. EF, in original case. **(\$125)**
- c742. **(Autograph) Gold Medal Winning U.S. Women's 2000 Team Autographed Basketball.** Signed in black markers on official Spalding 2000 team basketball, Nr. 72 of 180. EF. **(\$750)**

745. **SALT LAKE CITY, 19th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 2002 Official Torch.** Silver colored metal and glass, 83.8cm (33") long. Shaped like a fiery icicle in motion, the polished silver colored bottom bears the motto "Light the fire within"; center metal and glass top section in "frozen flame" texture with logo on metal part. EF. **(\$2,500)**
746. **Participation Medal.** Bronze plaque, 49x89mm, by O.T. Tanner. "Light the Fire Within" motto and Salt Lake City 2002 logo on Utah's famous arch, mountain view in back. Rev. Three athletes dashing out of mountain between legend and Olympic rings. EF, cased., with linen bag. **(\$450)**
