For the first time since Amsterdam 1928, the design of the winner's medals was changed. From now on the medals will reflect the fact that Greece was the country where the Olympic Games originated, and saw their revival. Baseball was an Olympic event 1992-2008 only. Medal EF. In wood and steel case with blue logo on top. Minimum Bid (\$11,000)
