- c286. **Bronze Third Place Winner's Medal.** Bronze, 60mm by C. Affer. Female head facing, crowned by Olympic rings, flame in lower r. Rev. Snowflake over Mount Pomagagnon. Brown-green patina, as made, EF. (\$3,500)
- 287. **Boxed Participation Medal.** Bronze, 45mm, by C. Affer. Female head facing, crowned by Olympic rings, flame in lower r. Rev. Snowflake superimposed on Mount Pomagagnon. Toned EF. In original yellow cardboard box, trace of tape on top, lt. scuffing. Rare with box. (\$1,000)
- 288. **Participation Medal.** As preceding bronze medal, no box. EF. (\$650)

- 290. Italian Olympic Committee Silver Award Medal for Mozellini, Second Place Winner in Four-Man Bob, 1956. Silver, 50mm. Helmeted head r. of Roma. Rev. 4-line engraved legend under CONI logo. EF, in blue leather case (trace of removed tape), lined in velvet and silk. (\$1,000)
