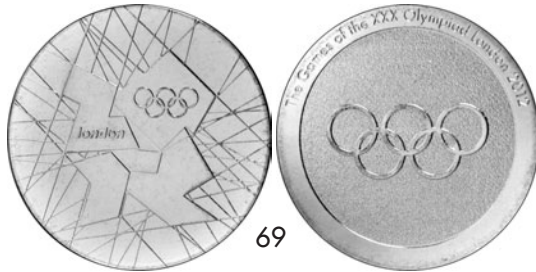

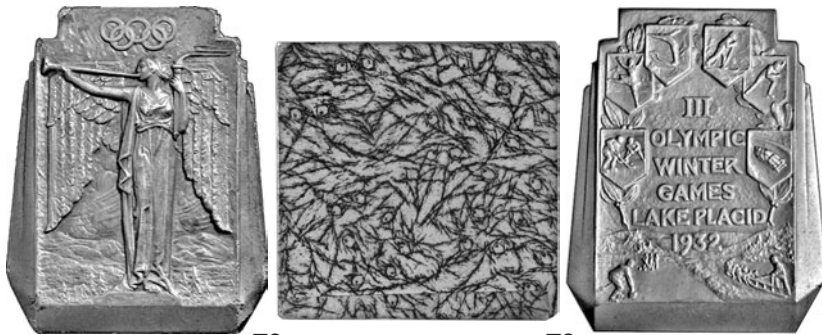

68. **Beijing 2008. Boxed Participation Medal.** Copper, 55mm. Logo over Bird's Nest Olympic Stadium. Rev. Five Fuwa mascots over Chinese and English "One World One Dream" motto, waves below. Unc., in red presentation box. (\$400)
69. **London 2012. Participation Medal.** Cupro-nickel, 39mm. London 2012 logo. Rev. Olympic rings. Housed in black cardboard holder with London 2012 logo. Unc. (\$350)

- PARTICIPATION MEDALS OF THE WINTER OLYMPIC GAMES**
- c70. **Chamonix 1924 Winter. Participation Medal and Third Place Winner's Medal.** Bronze, 55mm, by R. Bénard. Victorious athlete holding skates and skis, Alps in background. Rev. French legend in 14 lines. *First participation and winner's medal of Winter Olympic games. The only time that the participation medal was the same as the winner's medal. There were only 258 participants in Chamonix.* Two small holes at top and bottom, o.w. EF. (\$10,000)
71. **St. Moritz 1928 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 37mm, by M. Martin. Victory with laurel branch in horse-drawn sled to left, Olympic rings in exergue. Rev. French legend in six lines over laurel branch. Tiny rim nicks, dark toned EF. (\$800)
72. **Lake Placid 1932 Winter. Cased Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60x48mm, by Julio Kilenyi. Winged figure of Fame blowing horn, Olympic rings above, winter landscape in background. Rev. Six winter sports depicted on shields around legend in six lines, scenes of curling and dogsledding below. EF. Housed in its original cardboard box – extremely rare. (\$12,500)

- c73. **Garmisch-Partenkirchen 1936 Winter. Silver Participation Medal.** Silvered bronze, 60mm, by M. Joerres. Alpine summit over Olympic rings within German legend. Rev. Olympic motto over fir branches. *Presented to dignitaries and high officials.* Abt. EF, lt. rubbing on rev. Very scarce. (\$2,250)
74. **Garmisch-Partenkirchen 1936 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm, by M. Joerres. Alpine summit over Olympic rings within German legend. Rev. Olympic motto over fir branches. EF. (\$1,750)
75. **St. Moritz 1948 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 40mm, by Wiederkehr. Olympic rings over French legend in five lines. Rev. Symbolic figure of Victory, mountain range in back. Toned EF. (\$1,100)
76. **Oslo 1952 Winter. Participation Medal.** Copper, 56mm, by V. Falireus. Oslo Olympic emblem, a silhouette of the Oslo City Hall with superimposed Olympic rings. Rev. Olympic motto surrounding large snowflake. EF. (\$1,200)

77. **Cortina d'Ampezzo 1956 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 45mm, by C. Affer. Female head facing, crowned by Olympic rings, flame in lower r. Rev. Snowflake superimposed on Mount Pomagagnon. Toned EF. (\$650)
78. **Squaw Valley 1960 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 50mm. Hand holding torch. Rev. Logo. Choice EF. (\$1,100)
79. **Innsbruck 1964 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 61mm, by Welz. Innsbruck Olympic emblem within German legend. Rev. Innsbruck city view, Austrian Alps in background. EF. (\$375)
80. **Grenoble 1968 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 68mm, by M. Coeffin. Profile of Greek athlete. Rev. City view of Grenoble. EF. (\$300)
81. **Sapporo 1972 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm, by S. Fukuda. Sapporo Olympic emblem. Rev. Two large arrows attached to stylized athlete. EF. (\$500)
82. **Innsbruck 1976 Winter. Participation Medal.** Silvered bronze, 50mm, by W. Pichl. Innsbruck Olympic emblem on ice crystals within German legend. Rev. Bergisel ski jump, panorama of Innsbruck and Austrian Alps in background. EF. Scarce in this condition. (\$500)
83. **Lake Placid 1980 Winter. Participation Medal.** Nickel-silver, 76mm, by M. Jovine. Modern relief views of nine winter sports. Rev. Lake Placid Olympic emblem surrounded by the words of the Olympic oath in four concentric circles. EF. (\$375)
84. **Sarajevo 1984 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60x66mm uniface, by N. Mitric. Stylized "Sarajevo 84", within circle, above Sarajevo Olympic emblem. EF. (\$475)
85. **Calgary 1988 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze, 64mm, by C. Martens. Calgary Olympic emblem, stylized snowflake design. Rev. Olympic motto under panorama of Calgary and Rocky Mountains. EF. (\$375)
86. **Albertville 1992 Winter. Participation Medal.** Chrome-plated steel, 68mm, by R. Mayot. Albertville Olympic emblem within French and English legend. Rev. Star symbol over Alps and Olympic rings within French legend. EF. (\$500)
87. **Lillehammer 1994 Winter. Participation Medal.** Copper, 66x76mm, by M. Kleppan. Pictograms of sporting events, ice crystals and Lillehammer Olympic emblem over Olympic rings. Rev. Modernistic ice crystal design with sports pictograms. EF. (\$375)

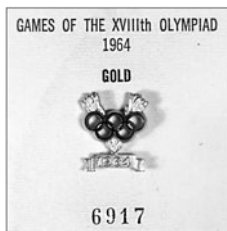

- 89. **Salt Lake City 2002 Winter. Participation Medal.** Bronze plaque, 49x89mm, by O.T. Tanner. "Light the Fire Within" motto and Salt Lake City 2002 logo on Utah's famous arch, mountain view in back. Rev. Three athletes dashing out of mountain between legend and Olympic rings. EF. (\$400)
- 90. **Torino 2006 Winter. Boxed Silver Participation Medal.** Silvered bronze, 39mm. Logo. Rev. Olympic rings over motto. With circular cardboard, within clear round box. EF. (\$350)
- 91. **Torino 2006 Winter. Boxed Bronze Participation Medal.** As preceding medal but bronze, presented to officials. With circular cardboard, within clear round box. EF. (\$350)
- 92. **Vancouver 2010 Winter. Participation Medal.** Silvered, 60mm. Graphics over logo and motto "With Glowing Hearts/Des Plus Brillants Exploits". Rev. Orca whale design and Olympic rings. EF, in presentation case and box. (\$400)

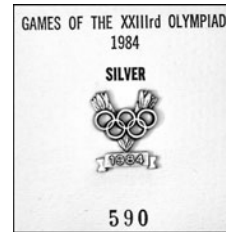

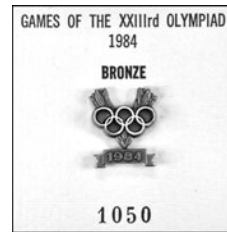

- c111. **Athens 1896. Scribner's Advertising Poster, April 1896.** Light and dark brown, and orange, 35.8x45.5cm (14.1"x17.9"), by H. Mayer. Ancient Greek warrior holding shield over fire on pillar, "The Olympic Games and their Revival" at left. Creases, professionally mounted on linen. Abt. EF. **(\$1,250)**
- c112. **Stockholm 1912. Official Poster.** 75x105cm (29.1"x41.3"), designed by Olle Hjörtzberg, Swedish Professor at the Royal Academy of Fine Arts, printed by A. Bortzells, Stockholm. Nude young men waving flags of participating nations, legend in Hungarian below. *At the time, the design was considered too daring by some countries, and the poster and seals with this design were not distributed in the respective countries.* Olympism p. 20/21. EF, a few marginal tears, lined on linen. Very scarce poster. **(\$3,750)**
- c113. **XXth Anniversary of the Restoration of the Olympic Games Poster, 1914.** Lithograph, 72.3x102.5cm (28.5"x40.4"), designed by E. Elzingre, printed by Affiches Atar, Geneva. Victorious athlete on horseback holding statue of Victory, horse led by 2 young boys. Olympism p. 153. Creased, lined on linen, VF-EF. Bright colors, beautiful poster. **(\$2,250)**
- c114. **Antwerp 1920. Official Discus Thrower Poster.** Lithograph, 62x88.5cm (24.4"x34.8"), designed by M. van Kuyck and W. v.d. Ven, printed by J.E. Goossens, Brussels, published by Belgian Railways. Discus thrower within flags of participating nations, Antwerp in background. EF, lt. marginal browning, lined on linen. **(\$3,000)**
- c115. **Antwerp 1920. Official Small Size Posters.** Multicolor Lithograph, 30.5x20.5cm (12"x8.1"), designed by Martha van Kuyck, and Walter von der Ven, printed by La Lithographie Artistique, Brussels. Discus thrower under flags of participating nations, part of Antwerp in background. EF, lined on linen. Rare. **(\$750)**
- c116. **Paris 1924. Official Javelin Poster.** Lithograph, 120x80cm (47.2"x31.5"), designed by Orsi, printed by Machar et Co., Paris. Large javelin thrower in front of globe, Paris skyline in background, "VIIe OLYMPIADE-JEUX OLYMPIQUES". Bright colors, creases, sm. tears, VF-EF, lined on linen. **(\$4,000)**
- c117. **Lake Placid 1932 Winter. Official Bobsled Poster.** Blue and gold, 101.5x63.5cm (40"x25"). Four-man bobsled team between Olympic Games legend, four illustrations of different Olympic Winter events at l. VF-EF, professionally lined on linen. **(\$2,250)**
- c118. **Los Angeles 1932. Official Poster.** Multicolor lithograph, 100x64cm (39.4"x25.2"), designed by Julio Kilenyi, printed by Union Litho Co. Athlete with laurel garland announcing the Olympic Games, between Olympic legend and rings. Olympism p. 41 var. Abt. EF, creases, small paper loss in word "July", repaired and professionally mounted on linen. Very scarce. **(\$3,500)**
- c119. **Garmisch-Partenkirchen Winter 1936. Small Size Official Poster.** Multicolor lithograph, 20x29.6cm (7.9"x11.7"), by Ludwig Hohlwein. Skier calling the Youth of the World to the 1936 Winter Games. EF, professionally mounted on linen. **(\$500)**
- c120. **Berlin 1936. Official Poster in English Language.** Designed by Frantz Würbel, Berlin. Multicolor offset printing, 63x101cm (24.8"x39.8"), published by the Publicity Committee for the Olympic Games. Olympic champion over quadriga on Brandenburg Gate. Olympism p. 45. Bright colors, minor tears professionally repaired. EF, lined on linen. **(\$3,500)**
- c121. **Berlin 1936. Official Brandenburg Gate Quadriga Olympic Games Poster.** Green and orange of offset printing, 62.7x101.1cm (24.7"x39.8"), designed by Friedel Dzugas and Krauss. Quadriga on top of the Brandenburg Gate in Berlin, between Olympic legend. Olympism p. 47. Lt. creases, abt. EF, lined on linen. Very scarce. **(\$2,000)**
- c122. **Helsinki 1940. Official Poster.** Multicolor lithograph, 69.7x104.3cm (27.4"x41.1"), designed by Ilmari Sysimetto, printed by Tilgman. Large figure of Paavo Nurmi, globe with Finland and Helsinki in back. Olympism p. 50/51. *Sysimetto's 1940 poster became the official poster for Helsinki 1952.* Creased on lower r., tape repairs at r., sm tears at top, lined on linen. Overall VF-EF. Scarce. **(\$2,000)**
- c122a. **Helsinki 1940. Italian Olympic Runner Poster, 1937.** Green and yellow, 70x100cm (27.6"x39.4"), by Carretto, Studio Boggeri, Backside by S. Patrone 1948, printed by Amilcace Pizzi S.p.A., Milan. Runner pictured on hat regarded as light as running (advertisement for a hat). Back view of a large Italian ocean steamer, below "Italia", name of the "Italian Shipping Society" to North and South America and the Pacific. Sm. tears, o.w. EF. **(\$750)**
- c123. **St. Moritz 1948 Winter. Commemorative St. Moritz Logo Poster.** Multicolor lithograph, 63.5x102cm (25.4"x40.2"), designed by Werner Weiskönig, printed by Art Institute Orell Füssli AG, Zürich. Large smiling sun, logo of St. Moritz, over Alpine landscape, "Olympische Winterspiele 1948". Olympism p. 57. Sm. tack holes in corners and at top, a few marginal tears, lt. creases, abt. EF. **(\$1,750)**
