500. **Bulgarian Torch Relay Medal.** Silver, 40mm. Hands passing flaming torch. Rev. Moscow and Bulgarian NOC logo surrounded by 13 city coat of arms touched by the torch relay in Bulgaria June 25 – July 1, 1980. EF. (\$100)
501. **Greek Torchbearer's Pin.** Silvered, blue enamel, 18x35mm. Presented to Greek torchbearers from Olympia to Athens. EF. (\$75)

**LOS ANGELES, 23rd OLYMPIC GAMES, 1984**

518. **Official Torch.** Brass-finished aluminum with tan leather handle, length 56.5cm (22.4"). Bowl portrays Olympic rings, motto and L.A. Memorial Coliseum Stadium. *Flame lit in Olympia, Greece on May 7, 1984, and it arrived in New York the following day. It took 82 days to carry the flame through 33 states, 9,375 miles, to Los Angeles.* EF, in original black leather pouch. (\$3,500)

519. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm, by D. Sterner. Olympic torch head within legend. Rev. Los Angeles Olympic emblem over Olympic rings and laurel branches. EF. (\$375)

520. **Cased Chinese Olympic Committee Medal.** Brass, 12.8cm (5"). Yellow enameled Chinese and English NOC legend surrounding color logo. The medal has a beautiful ring like a bell. *First time since 1952 that China participated again in Olympic Games.* Housed in silk case, VF-EF, with stand. EF, uneven toning. (\$200)

521. **Saudi Arabia Olympic Committee Medal.** Goldplated, partially color enameled, 8cm (3.1"). NOC logo over stylized laurel branches. Cased. EF. (\$125)

522. **Soviet Team Badge.** Goldplated, red enamel, 40x24mm. *The Soviet Union boycotted the Games in Los Angeles 1984.* EF. (\$100)
