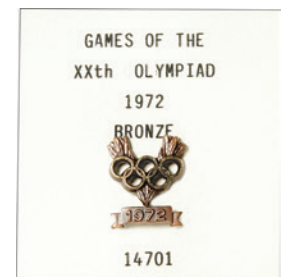

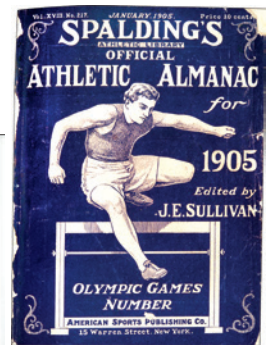

55. **Pyeong Chang 2018 Winter. Official Torch.** White, 70cm (27.6") long, the length matching the altitude of 700 Meter of Pyeong Chang. This symbol is shown also over the lower part in gold. *The flame was lit in Olympia, Greece, on October 24, 2017. After an 8-day relay in Greece the torch relay in Korea started on November 9.
