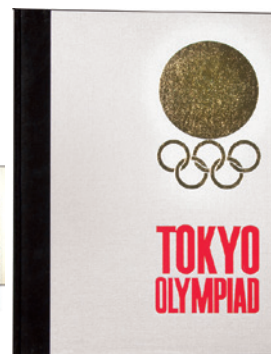

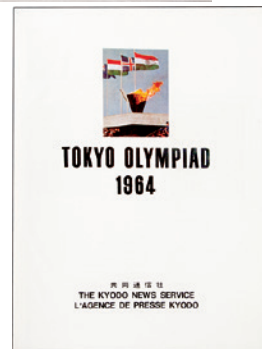

280. **Large Framed Gold Good Luck Sculpture.** Goldplated bronze, 21cm, Dragon around gilt Olympic rings, "1964 Tokyo" below. EF. Mounted on red velvet, in gold frame and wide linen border, inside wooden frame, 44x42cm (17.3"x16.5"), issued by the Japanese Olympic Committee. A few spots on linen, o.w. EF. (\$250)
281. **Opening Ceremony Ticket, October 10, 1964, 2:00 o'clock.** National Stadium, 18.1x8cm (7.1"x3.2"). Two folds, abt. EF. In original envelope with logo. (\$100)
282. **(Book) The Kyoto News Service. Tokyo Olympiad 1964.** 351pp. illustrated heavily in color and black & white, 26x34.5cm (10.2"x13.6"), captions in Japanese, English and French. Report from the lighting of the flame in Olympia, the torch relay, opening ceremony, the Games to the closing ceremony, and complete results. Bound in silver covers with gold and red, with paper slipcover. New. (\$200)
283. **(Book) The Spectacle of Tokyo Olympics 1964.** Tokyo, 1965. 239pp. of color and b&w photos, 26x36cm (10.2"x14.2"), captions in Japanese and English. Extensive report in photos from the Opening Ceremony to the Closing, plus 45pp. of results for all events. Bound in green leatherette, gold stamped, housed in blue linen case, stamped in silver, blue linen partially sunned. Beautiful report. EF. (\$300)
284. **Obunshah's Record and Book Special Edition. English for the Olympics.** Tokyo, 1962. 192pp., 19.5x19cm (7.7"x7.5"), in Japanese and English. Learning English to help overseas visitors with many questions about venues and events, plus history of the Olympic Games. Plus five 33 1/3rpm Records housed in a red book with padded covers (tape over lower spine). Contents EF. Rare. (\$200)

285. **National Olympic Committee Badge.** Goldplated, 37x52mm. Elbel W-3. EF. (\$650)
286. **Guest of Honor Badge.** Goldplated, 37x41mm. Logo in center color enameled. Elbel W-9. EF. (\$400)
- MEXICO CITY, 19th OLYMPIC GAMES, 1968**
287. **Official Black Torch.** Black painted aluminum, part of shaft made of wood, 52.8cm (20.9"). Silver colored doves around top. *The black torch was used in the torch relay from Olympia to Athens, Greece.* EF. (\$2,750)
288. **Miniature Silver Medal Winner's Badge Awarded for Rowing.** Silver, 16mm. Victory seated above stadium. Rev. Victorious athlete being carried by teammates. With rowing pictogram at top attached by loop and ring. Seldom seen badge, awarded with the medal. EF. (\$300)

289. **National Olympic Committee Badge.** Goldplated, red enamel, 37x63mm. With plastic ribbon in Olympic colors. Elbel S-2. EF. (\$550)
290. **Fencing Participant's Badge.** Goldplated, brown enamel, 37x63mm. Elbel S-145. EF. (\$250)
291. **Official Gold Guadalajara Medal, Venue of Preliminary Football Events.** Gold, 40mm, 41.6 grams, 21.7 Karat. Arms of Guadalajara over Olympic legend. Rev. "Jalisco" (State in which Guadalajara is located) within a circle of Aztec symbols. (\$1,500)
292. **Meeting of the IOC Executive Board Medal with the National Olympic Committees in Dubrovnik, 1969.** Goldplated bronze, 57x60mm, irregular shape. Ancient Greek winner's head with olive wreath over rings. Rev. City view. EF. (\$150)

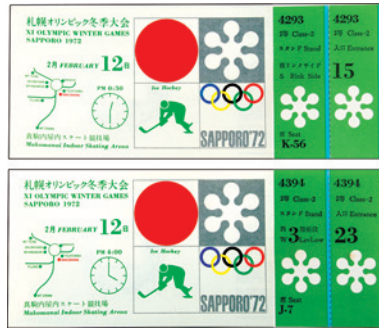

293. **Cased Bobsleigh Competitor's Badge.** Silvered, 37x59mm. "COMPETITOR" on green enamel. With brown ribbon. Elbel W-53. In original case. Lt. wear on silvered top, abt. EF. (\$500)
294. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm, by S. Fukuda. Sapporo Olympic emblem. Rev. Two large arrows attached to stylized athlete. EF, in original clear plastic case. (\$350)
295. **Official Torchbearer Medal.** Bronze, 32x33mm. Cauldron with Olympic flame. Rev. Logo. In original plastic box and sleeve with logo. EF. (\$120)
296. **Pair of Austrian Team Cufflinks and Tie Tack.** Goldplated, red and white enamel, 20mm and 50mm. Austrian eagle with Olympic rings and Japanese logo in center surrounded by "Austria Sapporo 72/XI Olympic Winter Games" in German. EF. (\$80)
297. **Austrian Team Patch.** Multicolor embroidery, 89mm. Austrian eagle with Olympic rings and Sapporo logo surrounded by legend. EF. (\$80)

298. **Downhill Skiing Mascot Bear.** Multicolor plastic, 11.5cm (4.5") high. Bear wearing goggles with skis under his arms. *Can also be a savings bank.* Rare. EF. (\$300)
299. **Luge Event Mascot Bear.** Multicolor plastic, 9cm (3.5") long, 9.5cm (3.7") high. Bear on sled, wearing goggles. *Can also be a savings bank.* Rare. EF. (\$300)
300. **Large Logo and Ice Hockey Player Ashtray.** Cast iron, black and gold design, 26.4x18.5cm (10.4"x7.3"). Large snowflake in center serving as ashtray, Sapporo logo and ice hockey player on sides. EF. (\$160)

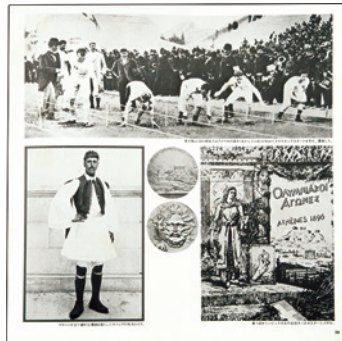
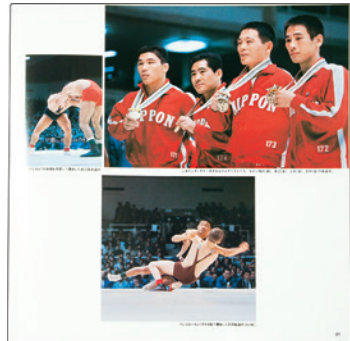

301. **Opening Ceremony Ticket, February 3, 1972, 11 a.m., Makomanai Speed Skating Rink.** 20x8.5cm (7.9"x3.4"). With envelope (spotty), ticket EF. (\$100)
302. **Pair of Ice Hockey Tickets, February 12, 1972, 12:30pm and 4pm, Makomanai Indoor Skating Arena.** 20x8.5cm (7.9"x3.4"). Both EF. (2 pcs.) (\$100)
303. **Official Guide to the 11th Olympic Winter Games, in English. Published by the Organizing Committee.** 267pp. illustrated in color and black and white, 21x28.7cm (8.3"x11.3"). History of Winter Olympiads, fold-out program, detailed venue description, uniforms, logo, tickets, medals, etc. Covers abt. EF, contents EF. Very informative and scarce. (\$150)
304. **(Book/Album) Guide and Book to the Sapporo Winter Games.** Published by the Organizing Committee. 38pp. of mostly color plates, plus actual postcards, and 12 album pages for photos, 29.3x30.5cm (4.5"x12"), in Japanese. 306. **Official Torch.** Steel, 73cm (28.8"), made by Krupp. *The fire was lit in Olympia, Greece on July 28 and carried 5539km in 29 days to Munich by 5976 runners.* EF. (\$2,500)
307. **Desk-Top Japanese Team Medal.** Bronze, 70mm, by Taro. Victorious runner at finish. Rev. Mascot Waldi over Olympic stadium. In clear acrylic case, 13cm (5.1") high. EF. (\$100)

308. **Iraq NOC Plaque.** Gilt, multicolor enamel, 10.2x12.8cm (4"x5"), by Picchiani E Barlacchi, Florence. Olympic flame over color rings, legend at top. Housed in presentation case, VF. Plaque EF. (\$175)
309. **Official Munich Olympic Hockey Stick Used in the Olympic Hockey Matches.** 92cm (36.2") long, made by Vampire. Names of the Indian Team, "Exclusively Used In Olympiad". *From a hockey participant.* VF+. (\$500)

310. **Official Napkin Box with Napkins from the Rowing Venue in Augsburg.** Chromeplated top and side and lucite plastic; 18.5x10cm (7.3"x3.9"), 6.5cm (2.3") high, made by WMF. Munich logo on top. Contains 10 red napkins. In pictorial box. EF. Rare. (\$250)
311. **Olympic City Munich Greet the World Beer Stein.** Multicolor, handpainted, 24cm (9.5") high. Olympic rings above Munich Frauenkirche and City Hall encircled by Edelweiss flowers, Alpine landscapes on either side. With pewter lid. EF. (\$125)
312. **Colorful Handpainted Beer Stein.** 19cm (7.5") tall. Munich Child in center flanked by Hofbäuhaus and Siegestor (Victory Gate), "München 1972" and Olympic rings at top. EF. (\$100)
313. **Large Cobalt Blue and Gold Commemorative Porcelain Plate.** 31cm (12.2"), made by Porzellan Manufaktur München. Munich landmarks with Olympic rings and gold logo, spirals. EF. (\$150)

314. **Original Royal Delft Olympic Porcelain Plate.** Blue and white, handpainted, 18.5cm (7.3") Cauldron with flame surrounded by "München 19-72 Olympiade" in center, border of flowers. In white leatherette case lined in blue, outside VF. Plate Unc. (\$120)
315. **Pair of Yellow and Green Javelin Thrower Ceramic Plates.** Each 24.3cm (9.6"). Olympic rings above athlete, Munich skyline with Olympic stadium in background. Surrounded by circular legend "Games of the XX Olypiade/München 1972" (translated from German). Both EF (2 pcs.). (\$120)
316. **Humoristic Bavarian Olympiad Porcelain Plate.** Multicolor, 26.8cm (10.6"). Seltmann porcelain. Bavarian young man caught in "Fensterlin" (climbing up to your girlfriend), smiling Bavarian lion and dachshund at left. EF. (\$100)
317. **Olympic City Munich Picture.** White and violet blue enameled iron plaque housed in white frame, 29.7x15.7cm (11.7"x6.2"). Olympic venue over city scape, Olympic rings and spiral logo at top. Small corner spots, o.w. EF. (\$100)
318. **Olympic Village News, September 6, 1972 - Terror in the Olympic Village.** 6pp., 26.5x37cm (10.4"x14.6"), in German. Issue about the Palestinian militants' terror attack on the Israeli team in the Olympic Village that shook the world. IOC President Avery Brundage declared the Games had to go on. Folded, VF. (\$120)

319. **Official Torch.** Steel, 74.6cm (29.4"), designed by Vereinigte Metallwerke Rantshofen. The design integrates a ski jump, with two sets of Olympic rings. Lt. handling, abt. EF. Rare. (\$22,500)
320. **Set of Six Commemorative Cauldron and Winter Sports Plates.** Blue and white porcelain, 9cm (3.5") each, made by Stettner & Co., Germany. The Olympic cauldron with flame, and five Olympic winter sports are featured. EF. (6 pcs.) (\$100)
