PARIS, 2nd OLYMPIC GAMES, 1900

The 1900 Paris Olympic Games were held in conjunction with the World's Exposition. They played only a minor role. There were athletes who didn't know that the events they participated in were Olympic Games events. Few items relate directly to the Games. For this reason we are also offering items commemorating the World Exposition.

- 171. Large Silver Jury Plaque. Silver, 7.3x12.8cm (2.9"x5") uniface, by L. Bottée, made by Christofle, Paris. Seated fame with palm branch and horn, "1900" within rays above, "Jury" on plaque below. Numbered. Housed in original case lined in green velvet. A beautiful plaque. EF. (\$850)
- 172. **French Minister of Sports Gold Award Plaque.** Goldplated bronze, 41x59mm, by F. Vernon. Victorious athlete standing on podium. Rev. 4-line French award legend over laurel branch. EF. (\$750)
- 173. Official Olympic Shooting Event Winner's Medal, and Miniature Medal. Bronze, 44mm and 20mm, by Charles Marey. Winged female holding fallen soldier. Rev. French rooster on panel, 8-line French legend above. Both EF. (2 pcs.) (\$500)
- 174. Merit Cross of the French Republic Awarded for the Paris World's Exposition 1900. Goldplated, multi-color enamel, 70mm. With green ribbon bordered by French Republic colors red-white-blue and "Croix De Mérite" bar over olive branch. *The World's Fair included the Olympic Games*. EF. (\$325)
- 175. Commemorative Paris 1900 Exposition Medal. Bronze, 53mm, by G. Lemaire. Seated female personifying Paris. Rev. Panel over airship, camera, anvil, etc. *The medal was given to buyers of the "L' Exposition de Paris 1900" publication.* Toned EF. (\$100)

ST. LOUIS, 3rd OLYMPIC GAMES, 1904

The 1904 Olympic Games in St. Louis were also held in conjunction with a World's Fair. This, again, detracted a lot from the importance of the Games. Few items are available that relate directly to the Olympiad, and they usually command very high prices. For this reason, we are also offering some memorabilia from the World's Fair which celebrated the Centennial of the Louisiana Purchase from Napoleon in 1803.

- 177. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 40x40mm, made by Dieges & Clust, New York. Nude athlete striding r., laurel branch in hand. Rev. Legend in eleven lines, shields of St. Louis, France and U.S.A. between ivy leaves. Toned EF. Rare medal for the Olympic participants. (\$20,000)
- 178. Gold Award Medal of the St. Louis Universal Exposition, 1904. Bronze, 68x68mm, by Weinmann. Louisiana cloaking Indian maiden. Rev. Eagle with outspread wings on panel with award legend. Housed in red award case with gold lettering on top, scuffed. Medal EF. (\$220)



179. Silver Award Medal of the Philippine Exhibit at the Louisiana Purchase Exposition 1904. Silvered bronze, 66x66mm, by Weinmann. America cloaking Louisiana. Rev. Eagle with spread wings on panel with award legend, two dolphins below. Toned abt. EF. Very rare medal. (\$300)

LONDON, 4th OLYMPIC GAMES, 1908
