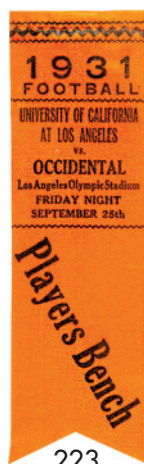

222. (Book) Coubertin, Pierre De. *Memoires Olympiques – Olympic Memories*. Lausanne, 1931. 218pp., 11.7x19cm (4.6"x7.5"). Very interesting book on Coubertin's recollection on each of the modern Olympic Games since 1896. Paper covers, chipped on lower right, sunned, contents browning, unopened pages, abt. EF. (\$150)

223. **1931 Football Players Bench Badge, University of California at Los Angeles Vs. Occidental, Los Angeles Olympic Stadium, Friday Night, September 25th.** Orange and black, 4.8x16.2cm (1.9"x6.4"). EF. (\$80)

224. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 48x60mm, by Julio Kilenyi. Winged figure of Fame blowing horn, Olympic rings above, winter landscape in background. Rev. Six winter sports depicted on shields around legend in six lines, scenes of curling and dogsledding below. EF. (\$8,000)

225. **\$30 Bleacher Season Ticket.** Cream, orange and black celluloid, 9.5x5.8cm (3.7"x2.3"). EF. (\$120)

226. **Charles Lindbergh Medal in the Olympic Art Exhibition.** Goldplated bronze, 72mm, by Frederic MacMonnies. Bust half l. of aviator crossing the Atlantic. Rev. The Lone Eagle surrounded by Death, Storm and Thunder. SOM issue #4. *MacMonnies was awarded Second Prize in the Medals and Relief's Section of the Art Competition and Exhibition for this medal. No First Prize was awarded.* EF, in original box. (\$250)

227. **Tenth Olympiad Yachting Pin.** Goldplated silver, 20mm, center shield enameled in color. EF. (\$160)

228. **Commemorative Discus Thrower Ring.** Silver, 20mm. Discus thrower with Olympic rings and Los Angeles 1932 Olympic legend. Ornate hammered design on sides. EF. (\$180)

229. **Commemorative Car Plaque.** White metal, 15.6x15.8cm (6.1"x6.2"). Spread wings behind discus thrower over globe showing the Americas, "Olympic Games Los Angeles 1932" legend and Olympic rings. EF. (\$150)

230. **Commemorative Olympic Key to the Los Angeles City Hall.** Silvered bronze, 23cm (9.1") long, made in Japan. View of the new city hall. Rev. View of the 1932 Olympic Stadium. VF. (\$90)

231. **Olympic Deck of Cards.** B&W movie star cards, 56x87mm. "Call to the Olympic Games" poster on back of cards, front features flags of participating nations, movie stars, the Olympic stadium and other Olympic venues. In pictorial box, VF+, cards EF. (\$150)

232. **Xth Olympiad Los Angeles Wall Hanging.** Embroidered velvet, 31x43cm (12.2"x16.9"). U.S. shield between Olympic rings and crossed olive branches and legend. Tassels at bottom. With wooden rod and cord for hanging at top. EF. (\$500)

233. **Xth Olympiad Discus Thrower Wall Hanging.** Multicolor velvet, 62.8x81.7cm (24.7"x32.2"). Olympic discus thrower over flowers and fruits, stadium in background, Olympiad 1932 logo at lower left. Lt. discoloration on sides, sm. frayed spot at bottom, VF- EF. (\$450)
234. **Commemorative Discus Thrower Pillow.** Multicolor painted stiff linen, 39.5x37.5cm (15.6"x14.8"). Discus thrower between Olympic stadium decorated with flags of participating nations and L.A. 1932 logo above Southern California home with palm tree at r. Corners lt. scuffing, o.w. EF. (\$200)
235. **Commemorative Child's Winter Kimono.** Multicolor, about 93cm (36.6") long. Images of Olympic trophy with "1932" and Olympic rings; entry to Los Angeles Coliseum Stadium, Japanese, U.S. and other nations flags, hurdles, long jump, pole vault, etc. A few small stains, abt. EF. (\$180)
236. **Boxing Ticket, August 9, 1932, 2p.m.,** Olympic Auditorium, Price \$1.00. Red, 11x6.5cm (4.3"x3.6"). EF. (\$90)

242. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm, by M. Joerres. Alpine summit over Olympic rings within German legend. Rev. Olympic motto over fir branches. EF. (\$1,200)
243. **Small Size Official Poster.** Multicolor lithograph, 20x29.6cm (7.9"x11.7"), by Ludwig Hohlwein. Skier calling the Youth of the World to the 1936 Winter Games. EF, professionally mounted on linen. (\$300)
244. **Official Daily Program, February 14, 1936.** 41pp. illus., 13.5x20.5cm (5.3"x8.1"), in German, English and French. Ice Hockey, Figure Skating, Military Patrol, etc. Blue covers. EF. (\$150)

BERLIN, 11th OLYMPIC GAMES, 1936

245. **Berlin 1936. The Golden Chain of Office for the Members of the International Olympic committee.** Produced by the sculptor Walter B. Lemeke from the originals in the Old Museum

in Berlin. Cast bronze, approximately 80cm (31.5"). Six small plaques are linked by rings. Left side: Horseman with relay torch, silver coin from Taranto, 300 B.C.; Javelin thrower from bowl, 430 B.C. Discus thrower, silver coin from Cos, 500 B.C.. Right side: Wrestlers, silver coin from Aspendos, 400 B.C.; Runner bearing arms, from bowl, 500 B.C.; and Youth with jumping weights, from bowl, 490 B.C. The two lower plaques are linked by enameled Olympic rings, from which is suspended a plaque with the famous head of Zeus, stone sculpture. Reverse engraved "XI. OLYMPIADE BERLIN 1936" at top, leaving room for ten more Olympiads. Official report p. 126/127; Olympic Games News Service No. 33. There were 68 IOC members plus IOC President Baillet-Latour at the time of the Berlin games. The chain was only worn on the Berlin Olympic Games. Many questions remain unanswered about what happened to these chains that were stored in Berlin after the Games, for use again at the 1940 Helsinki Games which were cancelled due to the Soviet invasion and bombing of Helsinki in March 1940. The beautiful Chains are eagerly sought by advanced Olympic collectors who very rarely have a chance to try to own one of them. EF. (\$37,500)

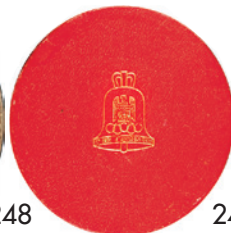

246. **Official Torch.** Steel, 27cm high (10.5"), made by Krupp Factory, designed by Carl Diem. Route of torch run from Olympia to Berlin on shaft, legend on top. Carried during the first Olympic torch relay from Olympia, Greece to Berlin, a distance of 307 km in 12 days. EF. (\$6,500)
247. **Bronze Third Place Winner's Medal.** Bronze, 55mm, by G. Cassioli. Victory seated above stadium. Rev. Winner carried by jubilant teammates. Toned EF. (\$7,000)
248. **Participation Medal with Red-Brown Patina.** Bronze, 70mm, by O. Placzek. Five athletes representing the five continents, pulling the ropes of the Olympic Bell. Rev. Olympic Bell embossed with German Eagle holding Olympic rings, within five concentric circles. Housed in red cardboard box with gold bell on top, lt. scuffing. Medal toned EF. (\$350)
- 248a. **Official City of Berlin Olympic Games 1936 Presentation Medal.** Cast bronze, 9.3cm (3.7"). High relief mural crowned city shield with high relief Berlin bear surrounded by German legend: "The Reich Capital City of Berlin, City of the Olympic Games 1936" (translated). Rev. Swastika above Olympic rings and Brandenburg Gate, 8-line German legend. In red presentation case lined with velvet and linen. EF. (\$300)
249. **Bronze Plaque Commemorating the Hungarian Homeing Pigeons at the Opening Ceremony.** Uniface, 57x82mm (2.2"x3.2"). Homeing pigeon on top of Hungarian double cross surrounded by Olympic rings with pigeons, "OLYMPIA/1936" in Hungarian below. Housed in presentation case, scuffed, plaque EF. Scarce. (\$300)
250. **Japanese Team Medal.** Silvered bronze, 36mm. Athlete standing on globe holding flag, large Olympic rings in back. Rev. Berlin Olympic bell inscribed "1936" encircled by Japanese legend. Fob-style loop at top. Abt. EF. (\$200)

251. **Bulgarian Team Silver Participant's Badge.** Silvered, partially gilt and red enamel, 32x42mm. Red crowned shield in open wreath, color rings at bottom. EF. (\$180)
252. **Yugoslavia Team Pin.** Silvered, 16mm, buttonhole closure. EF. Rare. (\$160)
253. **Honorary Price Plaque Awarded in the Olympic Preparation Year 1935.** Cast blackened iron, 11cm (4.3"), 13.5cm (5.3") high. Large swastika behind athlete with Olympic flag. Rev. Large German eagle holding Olympic rings. EF. (\$180)
