120. **(Ticket) July 5, 1924, Reunion 43, Opening Ceremony, Honor Tribune, Olympic Stadium in Colombes.** Green, 14.2x8cm (5.6"x3.2"). Faint center crease, abt. EF. (\$300)
121. **Identity Card of Austrian Participant A. Weinberger.** Stiff paper, 8x12cm (3.2"x4.7"). With photo. Lt. browning, abt. EF. (\$180)

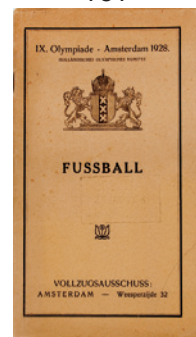

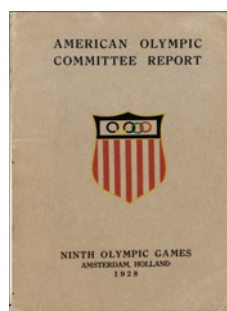

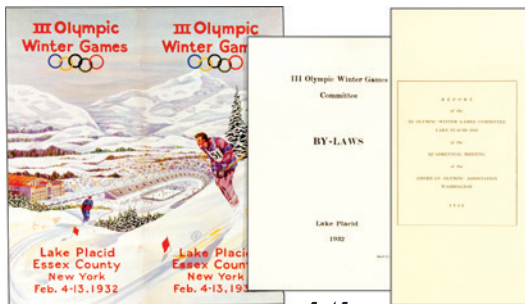

137. **U.S. Team Hat and Two Starting Numbers of Cross Country Skier Richard Parsons.** Hat ivory wool with U.S. team patch on front made by A.G. Spalding & Sons. Remarkably well preserved, EF. Plus **Starting Numbers: 18km Ski Race on February 10, Nr. 46**, small brown spot, o.w. EF. And **50km Ski Race on February 13, Nr. 30**. A few brown spots, VF-EF. *Clothing from Lake Placid 1932 is seldom encountered; very rare to find it also identified.* (3 pcs.) **(\$1,200)**
138. **Official Diploma Presented to Swiss Olympic Committee.** 35x25.5cm (13.8"x10"). Both sides of winner's medal flanking the text, outlines of participation medal behind. Rarely seen for a National Olympic Committee. EF. **(\$1,000)**
139. **Group of Four Daily Programs, February 5, 12, 14 and 15.** The February 14 program has a vertical crease, VF+, the other three are EF. (4 pcs.) **(\$150)**

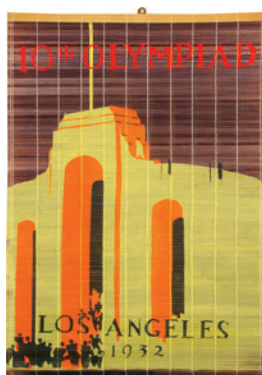

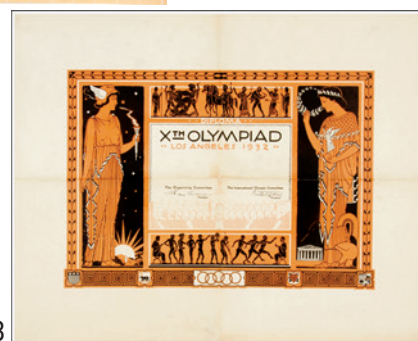

144. **Bronze Souvenir Winner's Medal.** Bronze, 55mm, by Cassioli. Victory seated above stadium. Rev. Winner carried by jubilant team members. "SOUVENIR" on edge. *A small number of the bronze winner's medals were inscribed "SOUVENIR" and presented to high officials.* Partially toned EF. (\$1,800)
145. **Participation Medal.** Bronze, 60mm, by J. Kilenyi. Standing athlete carrying unfurled banner of the Xth Olympiad. Rev. Two seated female figures supporting shield of the United States. Toned EF. (\$750)
146. **Participation Medal for a Member of the Chorus at the Opening Ceremony.** Bronze, 38mm, by J. Kilenyi (obv). Standing athlete holding Xth Olympiad 1932 flag. Rev. "Member of/Chorus/ in Appreciation" in three lines. Toned EF. (\$260)
147. **Gold Gymnastic Demonstration Participation Medal, August 10, 1932.** Goldplated bronze, 38mm, obv. by J. Kilenyi. Athlete unfurling flag with "Xth Olympiad 1932". Rev. Three-line legend. Very scarce goldplated, presented to an official. EF. (\$260)
148. **Swedish Team Pin.** Partially color enameled bronze, 12x16mm. EF. (\$200)
149. **Commemorative Discus Thrower Ring.** Silver, 20mm. Discus thrower with Olympic rings and Los Angeles 1932 Olympic legend. Ornate hammered design on sides. EF. (\$170)

150. **Commemorative "Olympics" in "Los Angeles 1932" Ashtray.** White metal, 8.7x13cm (3.4"x5.1"). Art Deco style shot put athlete on right between legend. Partially toned, abt. EF. (\$120)
151. **Genuine Olympiad 1932 Blanket For Use in the Olympic Village.** Light brown virgin wool with red and green stripes 150x192cm (59"x76"), made by Pendleton Woolen Mills, Portland, Oregon. With attached color label showing athlete with garland on top of the world. *Pendleton won the concession to make the Olympic blankets.* A few minor moth holes, overall EF condition. Rare. (\$800)
152. **Trio of Commemorative Wall Hangings.** Colorful bamboo, 36.5x53.5cm (14.4"x20.8"). Depicted are the Entry to the Olympic Coliseum Stadium, the Los Angeles City Hall, and the Olympic Bell with logo. Scarce set. All EF. (3 pcs.) (\$240)
153. **Official Diploma.** Orange and black, 60.7x48cm (23.9"x18.9"). Stadium and legend between frieze of ancient Greek athletes, Goddess Columbia and Athena at sides. Lt. browning, previously folded twice, lined on linen. VF. (\$600)
