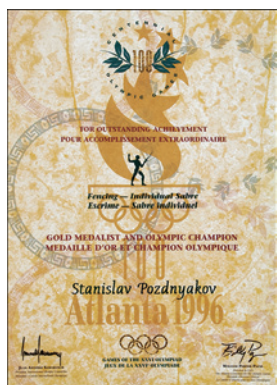

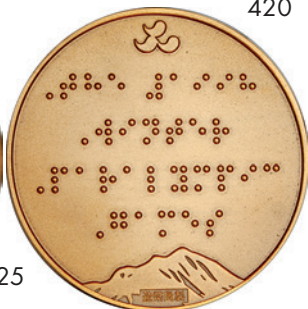

419. **Paralympic Mascot Blaze.** Plush, 26x25cm (10.2"x9.8"). EF. (\$260)
420. **Gold First Place Winner's Diploma Awarded to Stanislav Pozdnyakov for Fencing, Sabre, Individual on July 21.** Gold and green, 21.6x30.5cm (8.5"x12"). Centennial logo above fencer over Olympic rings and legend, facsimile signatures of IOC President Samaranch and OC President Payne. EF. (\$260)
421. **Gold First Place Winner's Diploma Awarded to Grigoriy Kiriyenko, Sabre Team on July 24.** Gold and green, 21.5x30.5cm (8.5"x12"). Centennial logo above fencer over Olympic rings and legend. Facsimile signatures of IOC President Samaranch and ACOG President Payne. EF. (\$260)
422. **Torch Relay Certificate.** Multicolor, 43x28cm (16.9"x11"). Also signed by the Olympic Flame Relay Committee President. Presented by the Hellenic NOC President Tzikas and the Atlanta ACOG President Payne. Signatures almost faded. EF. (\$100)

- NAGANO, 18th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 1998**
423. **Official Torch.** Aluminum, partially gilt, 55cm (21.7") long. Designed after ancient Japanese torches called Taimatsu. It shows the Nagano emblem and sports pictograms, and a brightly colored orange cord wrapped around the lower part forms the grip. Fueled with clean burning propane, it burnt for about 20 minutes. The torch relay in Japan took place from January 6 until February 7, when the Olympic fire was lit during the opening ceremony. Choice EF, in original cardboard box. (\$6,000)
424. **Small Size Official Torch in Presentation Case.** Aluminum, partially gilt, 27.7cm (10.9"). Designed after ancient Japanese torches called Taimatsu. It shows the Nagano emblem and sports pictograms, and a brightly colored orange cord wrapped around the lower part forms the grip. Only a very small number of these torches were made for presentation to high dignitaries. Torch is housed in a wooden case lined with green velvet. Brass plate commemorating the torch run Jan. 6 – Feb. 6, 1998. EF. Very rare. (\$1,800)
425. **Paralympic Games Participation Medal.** Bronze, 55mm. Logo and legend. Rev. Braille legend over mountains. Boxed. EF. (\$500)
426. **U.S. Team Pin Set.** 17 pins enameled in color, 35x40mm each. Each for a different sport. In original display case. EF. (\$100)
427. **Commemorative Nagano 1998 Olympic Beer Stein.** Multicolor ceramic, 20.5cm (8.1") high, by Ceramarte, Brazil. Official color logo flanked by logos of 6 previous Olympic winter games. With pewter top. EF. (\$80)
428. **Paralympic Games Official Report Published by the City of Nagano.** 16 color pages plus 105pp., illustrated in b&w, 21x29.5cm (8.3"x11.6"), in Japanese. Soft bound. EF. (\$100)

**SYDNEY, 27th OLYMPIC GAMES, 2000**

429. **Official Torch.** Three layers consisting of polished stainless steel, anodized aluminum and coated aluminum, 77cm (30.5"), designed by Blue Sky Design, Sydney, manufactured by G.A. & L. Harrington. The three layers represent earth, fire and water. Unused, EF. (\$3,750)

430. **Cased Paralympic Silver Second Place Winner's Medal.** Silver, 70mm, by Stuart Devlin. View of Opera House and Harbor Bridge surrounded by Paralympic venues. Rev. Logos of Sydney Paralympic OC and International Paralympic Committee. Unawarded. With green ribbon, housed in black leather case. EF. **(\$5,000)**
431. **Swiss Team Medal.** Silvered, partially enameled in color, 56x56mm. Color logo over Australian and Swiss shields. Rev. "With Thanks For Your Cooperation". EF, cased. **(\$100)**
- 431a. **Trio of Paralympic Commemorative Medals.** Goldplated, silverplated and bronze, 38mm, struck by the Perth Mint. View of Sydney Bridge and Opera House. Rev. Paralympic logo over medals. Toning on bronze medal, all EF, housed in Perth Mint case. **(\$120)**
432. **Sydney 2000 Olympic Games Art Object from the Sydney Torch Relay.** 41cm (16") tall, 15cm (5.9") wide. Made in 3 layers of steel from the same coil of steel as the Olympic flame cauldron, blue and clear glass representing the blue Pacific Ocean, and a silver inlay on the torch relay logo from the same silver used to strike the Sydney 2000 winners medals. This art object was auctioned during the Sydney Olympic Torch Relay. It beautifully represents the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games. Numbered. EF. **(\$1,500)**

433. **Silver Second Place Winner's Diploma Awarded to Oleksandr Beresh for Artistic Gymnastics, Men's Team.** 29.5x21cm (11.6"x8.3"). Last time President Samaranch's facsimile signature is on the diplomas. EF. **(\$280)**
434. **IOC President J.A. Samaranch Recognition Medal on his Retirement, 2001.** Silvered bronze, 65mm, by B.O. Smiling bust facing of IOC President from 1980-2001. Rev. 8-line legend in English, to the Unifier of the Olympic Movement on his retirement. Unc., cased. **(\$120)**
435. **SALT LAKE CITY, 19th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 2002 Official Torch.** Silver colored metal and glass, 83.8cm (33") long. Shaped like a fiery icicle in motion, the polished silver colored bottom bears the motto "Light the fire within"; center metal, and glass top section in "frozen flame" texture with logo on metal part. EF. **(\$3,250)**
436. **Swiss Team Medal.** Silvered, partially enameled in color, 56x56mm. Color logo over U.S. and Swiss shields. Rev. "altogether for success! thank you". EF, cased. **(\$100)**
437. **Official Mascots Snow Globe.** Multicolor, 14.5cm (5.7") high, 10.5cm (4.1") wide. Logo on top of globe surrounded below by 5 sets of mascots showing Olympic sports. **Plus Cowboy Hat Pin.** Gold and black, 38x29mm. Very popular pin in 2002! Both EF. (2 pcs.) **(\$100)**

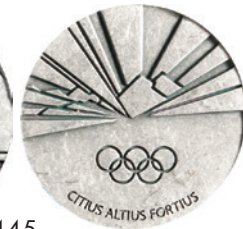

438. **Participation Diploma.** Violet and gold, 19.1x27cm (7.5"x10.6"). With envelope. EF. (\$120)

**ATHENS, 28th OLYMPIC GAMES, 2004**

439. **Paralympic Participation Medal.** Bronze, 50mm. Athens 2004 Paralympic logo. Rev. Legend. Greek text and wavy decoration on both sides. With cardboard covers, space for participation certificate inside back cover. EF. (\$150)

440. **Participant's Pin Presented by the IOC.** Gilt, 14x19mm. Numbered, in white plastic wallet. EF. (\$80)

441. **Commemorative Olive Wreath.** Oxidized copper, 28x26cm (11"x10.2"). Olive wreath with olives mounted on black marble base with gold inscribed legend. *Olive wreaths were presented to Olympic winners in the 2004 Games as they had been presented in the ancient Games.* EF. (\$300)

442. **First Asian Indoor Games in Bangkok, 2005. Silver Second Place Winner's Medal Awarded for Swimming.** Silver, 70mm. Logo above legend surrounded by "Dawn of the Asian Stars". Rev. Stylized swimmer and "Swimming", Games name and date. With blue and white ribbon, border in red. EF. (\$260)

**TORINO, 20th OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 2006**

443. **Official Torch.** Blue techno-polymer-coated aluminum, 77cm (30.3") long, made by Pininfarina. *The fire was lit in Olympia on November 27, 2005 and arrived in Rome on December 8. Until February 10 the torch traveled over 11,300 km across Italy, also France, Switzerland and Slovenia. Used in the torch relay, light darkening around upper part (may be wiped off).* EF. (\$1,800)

444. **Gold Participation Medal.** Goldplated bronze, 39mm. Logo. Rev. Olympic rings over "Citius Altius Fortius". In clear round plastic case. Rare. EF. (\$900)

445. **Pair of Silver and Bronze Participation Medals.** Silvered bronze and bronze, both 39mm. Logo. Rev. Olympic rings over "Citius Altius Fortius". *Medals were presented to the participants (silver) and the officials (bronze).* Both EF, in clear round plastic cases. (2 pcs.) (\$200)

446. **Swiss Team Medal.** Silvered, partially enamelled in color, 56x56mm. Logo over Italian and Swiss shields. Rev. "We are on fire!" logo. Unc., in presentation case. (\$100)

**BEIJING, 29th OLYMPIC GAMES, 2008**

447. **Football (Soccer) Silver Second Place Winner's Medal, Housed in its Presentation Case.** Silver, 70mm, with circle of inlaid green jade on reverse. Winged goddess of Victory above Panathenian Stadium in Athens. Rev. Logo in center surrounded by jade, event engraved at top and bottom. Ornate loop, with red and orange ribbon with "Beijing 2008" and Olympic rings. Housed in red lacquer box and large silver silk case. EF. **(\$10,000)**
448. **Official Torch.** Red and anodized aluminum, 72cm (18.4"). Curved form in the shape of a paper scroll, with lucky clouds graphic expressing harmony. *The torch relay started in Olympia, Greece, on March 24, traveled to over 100 cities on five continents and all of China, a distance of 137,000km.* EF. **(\$5,000)**

449. **Swiss Team Medal.** Silvered, partially enameled in color, 56x56mm. Color logo over Chinese and Swiss shields. Rev. "Passion, Power, Performance" over flower with 5 petals. EF, cased. **(\$100)**
450. **Model of the Bird's Nest Stadium.** Gold colored on black base, 20.5x12cm (8.1"x4.7"). Top of stadium lifts off to show the inside of the stadium. EF. **(\$100)**
451. **Silver Second Place Winner's Diploma Awarded for Boxing 54kg Bantam Weight.** Silver silk, 46x35.1cm (18.1"x13.8"), in Chinese, French and English. EF. **(\$350)**

**VANCOUVER, 21st OLYMPIC WINTER GAMES, 2010**

452. **Official Torch.** Stainless steel, aluminum and sheet molding compound, 94.5cm (37.1"), made by Bombardier. The lines of the torch reflect the lines made by snow and ice winter sports. It shows the engraved motto "With Glowing Hearts / Des plus brillants exploits" and the logo. *The torch relay ended after its 45000km journey*

453. **Pair of Participation and Volunteers Medals.** 60mm and 40mm. Graphics over logo and motto "With Glowing Hearts/Des Plus Brillants Exploits". Rev. Orca whale design and Olympic rings. Both in cases, EF. (2 pcs.) **(\$260)**
454. **Swiss Olympic Team Medal.** Silvered, partially enameled in color, 56x56mm. Logo above Canadian and Swiss shields. Rev. Motto above Swiss logo. Unc, in presentation case. **(\$100)**

**LONDON, 30th OLYMPIC GAMES, 2012**

455. **Official Torch.** Gold-colored aluminum alloy, 80cm (31.5"), designed by Edward Barber and Jay Osgerby, made by The Premier Group, Coventry. Triangular form made out of an inner and outer sheet with 8000 holes representing the 8000 torch bearers in Great Britain. EF. **(\$5,000)**
456. **Horse's Third Place Equestrian Award Ribbon.** Large logo in center surrounded by purple rosettes edged in bronze, 16.5cm (6.9"). With two long purple ribbons, one inscribed "London 2012" and Olympic rings. EF. **(\$800)**
