

**LOS ANGELES, 23rd OLYMPIC GAMES, 1984**

- 408. **Official Torch with Pouch.** Brass-finished aluminum with tan leather handle, length 56.5cm (22.4"). Bowl portrays Olympic rings, motto and L.A. Memorial Coliseum Stadium. *Flame lit in Olympia, Greece on May 7, 1984, and it arrived in New York the following day. It took 82 days to carry the flame through 33 states, 9,375 miles, to Los Angeles.* Partially toned, small flaking at top part, VF-EF, in original black leather pouch. **(\$3,500)**
- 409. **Los Angeles Organizing Committee 1983 Model for the 1984 Torch.** Polished steel with brown leather handle, 50cm (19.7") tall, made by Turner Ind., Inc., Irwindale, California. Design and writing in color. Attached to a square clear plastic base, 18.5x18.5cm (7.3"x7.3"), 5.5cm (2.2") high. EF. **(\$4,000)**
- 410. **Official Presentation Torch with Pouch and Copy of Organizing Committee President Ueberroth Letter.** Brass finished aluminum with tan leather handle, length 56.5cm (22.4"). Bowl portrays Olympic rings, motto and L.A. Memorial Coliseum Stadium. With copy of **Ueberroth Presentation Letter** to his assistant Charlotte Hyde. With black leather pouch. Leather on torch faded, o.w. EF. **(\$3,000)**
- 411. **88th IOC Session in Los Angeles, 1984. National Olympic Committee Badge and Press Badge.** Each 35x60mm, with green ribbon and yellow ribbon. Both EF. (2 pcs.) **(\$100)**
- 412. **Commemorative Torchbearer Sculpture.** Bronze and resin alloy, 26cm (10.3") tall, by Marcel Jovine. Male and female torch runners holding flaming torch. EF. **(\$120)**





Set contains the five Olympic rings set against the French Alps, same design as the winner's medals for Albertville 1992; the powerful slalom skier and the ski jumper in mid-flight. Olympic legend below. Each housed in velvet-lined case, with numbered certificate. *The black background is not part of the set.* Beautiful set from famous Lalique Company. All EF. **(\$400)**

436. **Pair of Paralympic Mascots Petra.** Multicolor plush, 29cm (11.4") each. They are slightly different from each other. Both EF. (2 pcs.) **(\$350)**
437. **Austrian Minister Honors the Successful Participants in the Barcelona 1992 Olympic Games.** Silvered plaque 13x17cm (5.1"x6.7"), attached to blue velvet, and housed in a blue leatherette case. EF. **(\$120)**
438. **(Bid Book) Amsterdam 1992. Proposal to the IOC For The Games of the XXVth Olympia.** 240 pages, numerous color plates, bound in red linen gold legend; 31.5x31.5cm (12.4"x12.4") in English. Each sport described. EF. **(\$120)**



One of only 300 torches, rarely seen, and the largest of all Olympic torches. Used in the torch relay, blackened around wood at top. 3 cotton pieces for lighting at top. VF-EF. (\$35,000)

442. **Official Souvenir Torch.** 60cm (23.8"), wood and metal engraved with 6 winter events. Accompanied by wooden display stand, 31cm (12.2") tall featuring Lillehammer logo and torch runner. EF. In original pictorial box. (\$150)

443. **Participation Medal Housed in its Wooden Case.** Copper, 66x76mm, by M. Kleppan. Pictograms of sporting events, ice crystals and Lillehammer Olympic emblem over Olympic rings. Rev. Modernistic ice crystal design with sports pictograms. EF, cased. (\$300)

444. **The Torchbearer Pin in Gold Housed in its Wooden Box.** Gold, 15x26mm. With brochure, EF. (\$160)

445. **Torchbearer Sculpture.** Blackened iron, 34cm (13.4") tall. Pictogram torchbearer on numbered base. EF. (\$200)

446. **Official Results.** 402pp., 22.9x22.5cm (9"x8.9"), in Norwegian, English and French. Pink pictorial covers. Light traces of water stains, VF+. (\$80)
